**SCHOOL-BASED FEEDING PROGRAM (SBFP) IMPLEMENTATION
FOR SY 2023-2024**

To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent

All Division SBFP Technical Working Group

Attention: **All School Based Feeding Program Coordinators**

1. Please be informed that the **Conduct of the School-Based Feeding Program (SBFP) Implementation for SY 2023-2024 shall commence on January 9, 2024.**
2. Along with the implementation, the delivery of the nutritious food products shall be in the designated drop-off schools, on weekly basis or once a week and scheduled every Tuesday of the week starting **January 9, 2024.** School heads of the recipient schools are directed to facilitate the retrieval of the delivered goods.
3. Please see attached list of drop-off schools. The nutritious food products (NFP) composed of the following to wit;
 - a) enhanced nutribun (purple sweet Potato, yellow sweet potato, carrot and squash variant) and fortified bread.
 - b) various food commodities (cereals mix drinks oats chocolate flavor, fresh eggs, banana chips, butter cookies with malunggay, nutri- rice porridge (chicken tinola)
 - c) fresh Fruits (fresh ripe banana (lakatan), fresh ponkan and fresh apple)
 - d) iron-fortified rice
 - e) ready to drink fruit juices (calamansi, carrot, passion fruit juice and tropical fruit juice
4. Please be noted that the distribution of the nutritious food products shall be strictly at the school feeding center and shall only be consume inside the school campus. However, for the SBFP-Milk Component implementation, we are still waiting for the



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mother Memorandum of Agreement from the Central Office, thus, schools shall be informed immediately on this regard.

5. The Division SBFP-TWG shall conduct monitoring to ensure strict compliance of the program implementation. Likewise, observance of the DepEd Order No. 14, s. 2020, minimum health standards/protocols and precautionary measures shall be strictly observed.
6. Further, the Division Kick-Off Ceremony shall be at Nanyo Central Elementary School on **January 10, 2024, 8:00am-12:00nn. Attention: Dr. Arlene L. Choi to facilitate the said activity.**
7. Travel expenses incurred during the retrieval of food commodities from the drop-off schools shall be charged against School MOOE/local funds, while travel expenses for the Division SBFP-TWG during monitoring shall be charged against local funds subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
