1. Pursuant to Republic Act No. 11223, an Act Instituting Universal Health Care for All Filipinos, Prescribing Reforms in the Health Care System, and Appropriating Funds, or also known as “Universal Healthcare Act”, the Schools Division of Panabo City through the Health and Nutrition Section initiated a partnership with the Emilio B. Rivera Primary Care Center Inc. of Panabo which shall facilitate the membership of all teaching and non-teaching personnel in the Schools Division of Panabo City to avail free consultation and discounted hospital expenses in healthcare services necessary to address various health issues, and provide valuable guidance to those seeking assistance.
2. In line with the MATATAG agenda of the department, this Office gives support to teachers to teach better through this program. Some of the benefits we can avail are the following:
 - a) Free consultation done by the specialist including your dependents;
 - b) Affordable laboratory packages for the Annual Physical Examination; and
 - c) In case of admission at Rivera Medical Center Inc., Doctor's professional fee will be charged against PhilHealth only if referred through EBR Primary Care Center Inc.
3. Further, we can avail other offered services, to wit:
 - a) Medical consultations for adults, children, women, pregnant, and elderly
 - b) Affordable laboratory tests
 - c) Affordable pharmacy
 - d) Maternal and Newborn Care
 - e) Minor Surgeries (Circumcision, Cyst Removal)

- f) Physical Examination and Medical Certificates
- g) Vaccinations/Immunizations
- h) Counseling and Palliative Care

4. All teaching and non-teaching personnel are required to register to the program through the Emilio B. Rivera Primary Care Center Inc. at Peda Street, Panabo City, Monday to Friday 7AM-3PM, and Saturday 7AM-12nn.
5. Requirement to the registration is the updated PhilHealth MDR from Panabo Gym PhilHealth Office (details include dependents: spouse, children) or via online <https://www.philhealth.gov.ph> if first time clients. Afterwards, the 2nd and succeeding checkup, patients/clients can go directly to the partnered hospital. Lastly, for senior citizens, just bring PhilHealth ID or Senior's ID only. Thus, registration is free.
