Subject: TRAINING WORKSHOP ON CAMPUS JOURNALISM
CUM REGIONAL SCHOOLS PRESS CONFERENCE

Date: January 22, 2024

Pursuant to the thrusts and objectives of RA 7079 otherwise known as **Campus Journalism Act**, the Department of Education – Region XI through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division in partnership with the Davao Region Association of School Publication Advisers Inc. (DRASPAI) shall conduct the **2024 Training Workshop on Campus Journalism Cum 2024 Regional Schools Press Conference (RSPC)** with the theme, “*Championing the MATATAG Agenda as a Change Driver through Campus Journalism*”, on **March 11-13, 2024 group events**, in **Davao del Norte** and **individual events on March 19-22, 2024** to be hosted by **Davao de Oro Division** and **Municipality of Nabunturan** at **Nabunturan National Comprehensive High School** in particular.

The conference, aims to:

- a) demonstrate understanding of journalism through skillful execution in various platforms (i.e. print, broadcast, online);
- b) recognize the role of journalism in advocating social consciousness and environmental awareness;
- c) promote fair and ethical use of media as tenets of responsible journalism;
- d) foster camaraderie and enrich learning experiences through healthy and friendly competition; and
- e) provide learners opportunities to use the skills learned in campus journalism for their future careers;

The events to be contested for 2024 RSPC are the following:

1. **Individual Contests** such as News Writing, Editorial Writing, Feature Writing, Sports Writing, Copyreading and headline Writing, Editorial Cartooning, Photojournalism, Science and Technology Writing and Column Writing in English and Filipino of both elementary and secondary levels;
2. **Group Contests:** Radio Scriptwriting and Broadcasting and Collaborative Desktop Publishing (for elementary and secondary level); Online



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- Publishing Contest, and TV Scriptwriting and Broadcasting (for secondary level);
3. Search for Outstanding School Paper Advisers and Campus Journalists; and
 4. Group Contest - School Paper Category.

The following shall be the official participants in the 2024 RSPC:

- a. Top five (5) division winners of the individual writing contests;
- b. The first-place division winners in Group Contests;
- c. School Publication Advisers;
- d. Division Campus Journalism Focal; and
- e. Regional Technical Working Group.

A registration fee of **Eight Hundred pesos only (P 800.00)** shall be charged to each participant, remitted to the Cashier of Regional Office, to defray expenses for certificates, medals, plaques, trophies, honoraria of judges (Individual, Group and School Paper Contest, Accommodations, assistance to host schools and meals, while meals shall be managed by each division, transportation and other related expenses. Membership fees of **One Hundred Pesos (Php100)** for the SPA and **Ninety Pesos (Php 90.00)** for CJ shall be collected by the DRASPA, INC Treasurer. These are all chargeable against School's Maintenance and other Operating Expenses/ local/school/ Special Education Fund, School Campus Journalism Funds and other available funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

Recognizing and respecting Intellectual Property Rights, the Office adheres to the rule concerning plagiarism. This Department reiterates its stand to disqualify school paper found to have copied and published texts, graphics, and other materials without duly acknowledging their sources. **The disqualification covers all sections of the school paper whether they are published in print or electronically.** The Division Supervisors In-Charge of campus journalism shall be responsible for this aspect.

SDOs are enjoined to strictly follow the **"No School Paper, No Student Contestant"** in conducting the contest at the division level ensuring that all participants have their respective school paper.

The **top five winners** in all events per level per medium shall be recognized and the points from individual and group contests shall be included in the computation of the overall scores following the guidelines. However, only the **1st place winners in all events** will represent the Region in the 2024 NSPC.

Service credits shall be granted to teacher participants (DepEd Order No. 53, s 2003) while Compensatory Overtime Credits (COC) shall be granted to other non-teaching personnel (CSC and DBM Joint Circular No.2, s 2004) for the services rendered during weekends and holidays.

Observance of the **Department of Health's minimum public health standards** which include but shall not be limited to wearing of facemasks, physical distancing and other related measures related to the spread of Covid-19 is still reiterated. Billeting Schools will be secured by the Barangay Protection Office and should have **Child Protection Desk** and proper **Waste Management System** should be observed in all quarters. Classes of the schools use as billeting quarters and contest venues will be shifted to blended learning modality.

Additional info:

1. Contestants and coaches who will stay in billeting schools are advised to bring their own sleeping bags, pillows, and blankets.
2. Contestants who will participate in an official capacity should be given recognition by their schools in accordance with the applicable Deped policy on awards and assessment and should be considered make up for the full points of the projects, assignments, quizzes and other and other requirements that they missed.
3. Moreover, students are expected to stay at their designated areas (only at the billeting schools, contest venues and nearby stores to buy supplies or have some meals) for the duration of activity and should refrain from getting out except if they have secured permission thru a letter request signed by their parents/guardians and approved by the Division delegation head. In addition, students should be accompanied by their teachers or relatives when getting out of the schools.
4. Additional requirements for official contestants and coach, secure medical certificates and parents' consent to be submitted to the head of delegation.
5. Registration fees may also be used to provide cash incentives to the winners of NSPC 2024.
6. Public are not encouraged at the venue to limit the audience.
7. There shall be no opening program and parade, to maximize the time this will go directly to the contest proper because of the stages of elimination that the writers will undergo
8. Medical Team shall be provided by the delegation.
