Spelling Bee Mechanics

General Rules

1. The competition is for students in Elementary.
2. There will be three levels for this contest namely the easy, average, and difficult rounds. Each level has five words to be spelled correctly. In case of a tie after the difficult round, the contestants will proceed the clincher round to determine the winner for the place that they will competing for.
3. The contestants have 10 seconds to answer each word in the easy round, 20 seconds for the second round, and 30 seconds for the difficult round. In the event that the contestant would reach the clincher round, the contestant to write the correct spelling will get a point and will be determined the winner for the place that they will be competing for.
4. Contestants must the write the word after the "GO" signal. A contestant who has started writing without the "GO" signal will be disqualified to answer for that specific turn until the next word is given.
5. Erasures are strictly not allowed. An answer with erasure will be automatically considered WRONG.
6. All is qualified for easy, average and difficult rounds. Only those who need to break a tie will proceed to the clincher round.
7. The quiz master will read the part of speech of the word, meaning, and word to be spelled twice before the "GO" signal will be given.
8. For every correct spelling, the contestant will be given 1 point for all the rounds.
9. A contestant who has the highest point at the end of the difficult round will be determined CHAMPION.

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



Pursuant to DepEd Memorandum No. 019, s. 2024 dated March 12, 2024, this Office through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD) will conduct the 2024 Regional Festival of Talents (RFOT) with the theme "*Galing, Talino, at Husay ng mga Batang Makabansa sa Diwa ng MATATAG na Adhika*" on May 9-11, 2024(excluding travel time). The Schools Division Office (SDO) to host the activity will be identified in a separate memorandum.

Specifically, this activity aims to:

1. provide meaningful learning opportunities for basic education learners to display their talents and skills anchored on the learning competencies achieved in schools;

Participation is **voluntary** and shall not, in any way, affect the time-on-task of teachers as this activity's target learning standards and competencies are already embedded in teachers' actual classroom teaching and assessment process.

There shall be **no registration** for the 2024 RFOT. Travelling expenses, provision on food and other expenses (honorarium, supplies or contest materials, etc) shall be charged to the 2024 Basic Education Curriculum (BEC) Funds, local funds or other eligible fund sources, all subject to the usual government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

Further, all shall be entitled to service credits in accordance with DepEd Order 53, s. 2003 entitled: Updated Guidelines on the Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers and Compensatory Time-Off (CTO) as per Civil Service Commission (CSC) and Department of Budget and Management (DBM) Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004 on Non-Monetary Remuneration for Overtime Service Rendered on Saturday.

2024 NATIONAL FESTIVAL OF TALENTS

1. In line with the goal of delivering quality, relevant, inclusive, and responsive basic education, the Department of Education (DepEd) Curriculum and Teaching (CT) Strand, through the Bureau of Learning Delivery (BLD), will conduct the **2024 National Festival of Talents (NFOT)** with the theme, *Galing, Talino, at Husay ng mga Batang Makabansa sa Diwa ng MATATAG na Adhika* in **Region VII (Central Visayas)** on **July 9–12, 2024** (exclusive of travel time).
2. As provided in Republic Act (RA) No. 10533 titled **An Act Enhancing the Philippine Basic Education System by Strengthening Its Curriculum and Increasing the Number of Years for Basic Education, Appropriating Funds Therefore and for Other Purposes** and DepEd Order (DO) No. 021 s. 2019 titled **Policy Guidelines on the K to 12 Basic Education Program**, NFOT serves as a clear and proactive reinforcement of the teaching and learning process, reflecting the significant association between what the learners learned in school and what they actually performed and produced during this activity. Consistent with the Department's dedicated efforts to producing functionally literate and holistically developed Filipinos, all NFOT events are aligned with the essential learning competencies and standards of the K to 12 curriculum.
3. DepEd is expected to help achieve the much-needed protection and preference of local creatives and products, with the passing of RA 11904, also known as the Philippine Creative Industries Development Act. For this reason, NFOT shall contribute toward the goal of enhancing learners' competence in creative industries.
4. NFOT is a DepEd annual co-curricular activity that provides meaningful learning opportunities for basic education learners to display their talents and skills anchored on the learning competencies achieved in schools. It guides learners on which career path to take relevant to the four curriculum exits (higher education, middle-level skills development, entrepreneurship, and employment) of the Enhanced K to 12 Basic Education Program. Likewise, NFOT serves as a culminating activity of gauging learning mastery and skill development in accordance with learning standards.

5. NFOT supports the MATATAG agenda: **MA**ke the curriculum relevant to produce competent and job-ready, active, and responsible citizens; **TA**ke steps to accelerate delivery of basic education facilities and services; **TA**ke good care of learners by promoting learner well-being, inclusive education programs and ensuring that all learners, regardless of background, have access to quality learning opportunities and services; and **GI**ve support to teachers to teach better.

6. Participants in NFOT are learners from public and private elementary and secondary schools who will showcase their talents and skills and explore the culture of the host region. Together with their respective teacher-coaches during NFOT, they shall listen to the invaluable insights to be shared by the invited panel of experts after their performance; thereby, strengthening the teaching and learning of target learning competencies.

7. Participation in the 2024 NFOT is **voluntary** and shall not, in any way, affect the time-on-task of teachers as this activity's target learning standards and competencies are already embedded in teachers' actual classroom teaching and assessment process.

8. Since this activity falls on the end-of-school year break (EOSY), five-day service credits shall be granted to all participating teacher-coaches in accordance with DO 53, s. 2003 titled Updated Guidelines on Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers.

9. To ensure the safety, health, and well-being of all NFOT participants and delegates, strict observance of minimum health protocols shall be implemented within all activity premises.

10. The official logo, delegation per region, general guidelines, and specific guidelines for each skills exhibition are contained in the following enclosures:

Enclosure No. 1: Official Logo of the NFOT;

Enclosure No. 2: Distribution of Official Delegates;

Enclosure No. 3: General Guidelines on the Conduct of the 2024 NFOT; and

Enclosure No. 4: Specific Guidelines on the Conduct of the 2024 NFOT Events.

11. There shall be **no registration fee** for the 2024 NFOT. Traveling expenses of learner-participants and teacher-coaches and program support funds (PSF) for the conduct of the Regional and Division Festival of Talents shall be charged to the **2024 Basic Education Curriculum (BEC) Funds** and shall be downloaded to the regions while traveling expenses of other official delegates and those from the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region of Muslim Mindanao (BARMM) shall be charged to **their local funds** or **other eligible fund sources**, subject to the usual government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

12. The host region and division shall provide meals to participants in their billeting schools, including kits, identification tags, contest materials, and other eligible supplies and materials necessary for the conduct of the different events of the 2024 NFOT in accordance with the budget allocation. The first meal to be served shall be **dinner on July 8, 2024** while the last meal shall be **afternoon snacks on July 12, 2024**.


13. All designated heads of the regional delegations are advised to coordinate closely with the host region and division regarding the details of their arrival and

departure from the venue and ensure proper administrative arrangements with the concerned committees.
