2. NO ONE disturbs/talks to the Test Administrators and survey participants during the administration session. Only an assigned quality monitor from BEA, Division Testing Coordinator, or School Head is allowed, if required.
3. NO ONE (Division personnel or other school staff) is present on the test administration session.
4. NO individual person or school may be identified in any report released from the assessment program.
5. ALL data collected in SEA-PLM must be kept strictly confidential.

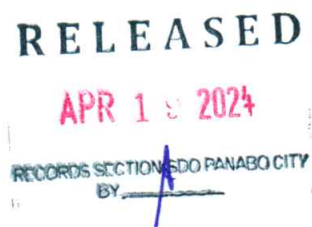

The Department of Education (DepEd), through the Bureau of Education Assessment (BEA), will administer the **Southeast Asia Primary Learning Metrics (SEA-PLM) 2019 Main Survey**, pursuant to DepEd Order No. 29, s. 2017 titled *Policy Guidelines on System Assessment in the K to 12 Basic Education Program*.

The goal of the SEA-PLM assessment is to measure the learning outcomes of Grade 5 students in Reading, Writing, Mathematics, and Global Citizenship, reflecting ASEAN Values, along with the background questionnaires for students, parents, teachers, and school heads to gather information about the social and educational contexts for learning.

SEA-PLM assessment results can be used to track trends in student learning outcomes over time and provide the educators, curriculum planners/crafters, and policymakers/implementers baseline data to identify areas in educational systems that necessitate improvement including teacher training and school management.

The SEA-PLM instruments shall be administered using **paper-and-pencil format** and shall be scheduled in the following batches:

| Batch | Testing Period       | Region                          |
|-------|----------------------|---------------------------------|
| 1     | April 22-26, 2024    | All regions in Mindanao and NCR |
| 2     | April 29-May 3, 2024 | All regions in Visayas          |
| 3     | May 6-10, 2024       | All regions in Luzon            |
