6. All expenses incurred for these competitions shall be chargeable against school local funds or any fund sources, all subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

12th BINULIG FESTIVAL CELEBRATION

HIYAS NG BINULIG 2024

(INTER- SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL)

THEME: "Gasa sa kahitas-an, Gialambo sa katawhan. Natagamtaman ug Gikalipay sa tanan."

GENERAL GUIDELINES & MECHANICS:

1. The candidate must be a resident in the City of Panabo and currently enrolled Senior High School in any schools in Panabo City, at least five feet two inches (5'2") in height, ages 15-22 years old, with pleasing personality, and must have been born biologically female;
2. The City Mayor's Office will be sending invitation letter in all schools in Panabo City with senior high school curriculum only. Application is available online via Google Form. The application is free of charge;
3. Applicants must attach their requirement in the Google Form on or before the screening day. Failure to submit required documents is subject for disqualification of application/entry;
4. Applicant must be single (has never been married, divorced or annulled), must not be pregnant or has never been pregnant and must not have been convicted of any crime;
5. During the screening the applicants must wear DECENT RED CASUAL ATTIRE (not too revealing), heavy make-up is discouraged. Each candidate is entitled to bring one personal assistant/make-up artist;
6. The Screening of Hiyas ng Binulig 2024 applicants is set on **SATURDAY, AUGUST 17, 2024, 1PM AT MAYOR'S FUNCTION HALL, 3F CITY HALL BUILDING, J.P. LAUREL, PANABO CITY** and must be in the venue one (1) hour before the scheduled time. Actual registration will start at 12:00 o'clock in the afternoon and will be closed at 1:30 PM only. Late applicants are subject to screening committee approval.
7. The candidate must prepare a brief opening spiel that talks about her and promotes the organization or group she represents;
8. Vulgar costumes and all attires are strictly not allowed and must conform to the Hiyas ng Binulig standards of prudence and conservatism;
9. The panel of screening committee will choose 15 official Hiyas ng Binulig 2024 candidates;
10. Title: **HIYAS NG BINULIG 2024**;
11. The **MINOR AWARDS**, to wit:
 - Best in Binulig Festival Attire;
 - Best in Creative Casual Attire;
 - Best in Long Gown;

- Best in Active Wear Attire;
- Best Performer;
- Miss Photogenic;
- Miss Congeniality; and
- People's Choice Award;

12. During the Q&A portion (preliminary and final) candidates can freely speak/answer in their own dialect or of their comfortable language in order for them to express their point of view with the maximum of thirty (30) seconds only;
13. **The winner will be committing herself to take in promotional activities for Binulig Festival and other events. Thus, the crowned Hiyas ng Binulig 2024 is prohibited to join any barangay and school level pageants within Panabo and Binibining Panabo 2024. This will be applicable during her reign;** and
14. The Judge's decision is final and is not open to any appeal. The Hiyas ng Binulig 2024 Search Committee will not entertain any form of protest at any time after the competition.
15. **The Binulig Festival Committee and Technical Working Group will have any right for any changes of the posted Guidelines and Mechanics if needed and inform the participants ahead of time before the actual competition;**

October 10, 2024 | (Thursday)

- **Sayaw sa Kadalan** | Time: 1:30PM – 4:00PM | Venue: Rizal Elementary School Grounds to Panabo Multi-Purpose Tourism Cultural and Sports Center
- **Binulig na Ani Dance Showdown** | Time: 5:00PM – 10:00PM | Venue: Panabo Multi-Purpose Tourism Cultural and Sports Center

GENERAL GUIDELINES:

1. Contest is OPEN to Elementary and Secondary Schools in the City of Panabo (Public & Private);
2. The organizers will accept five (5) official entries per category;
3. Contingents must be composed of:
 - Minimum of 50 and maximum of 100 members inclusive of performers, props men, and musicians. A deduction of 1 point per lack of excess of person will be sanctioned from the total score;
 - Minimum of 10 and maximum of 25 props men are allowed during the set up (pre-set). They should wear white T-shirt, for verification purposes;
 - Import of musical players is allowed with only 30% of the over-all musical player team. The 70% should be a student from the participating school;
4. Each group may use any art form (e.g. theatre, dancing, singing, contemporary, etc.) specified per category as long as it expresses a message of nurturing the environments to promote good harvest and festivity. **Theme: “Gasa sa kahitas-an, Gialambo sa katawhan. Natagamtaman ug Gikalipay sa tanan.”**
5. Must be in a tribal concept depicting any tribes of Panabo City (e.g. Ata, Manobo, Mandaya, Kalagan, Kagan, Mansaka, Bagobo, Dibabawon). It may be the original steps or neo-ethnic.
6. Each group must join the SAYAW SA KADALANAN on October 10, 2024 – 1:30PM from Rizal Elementary School Grounds to the Panabo Multi-Purpose Tourism, Cultural and Sports Center for the 1st and 2nd judging of the STREET PERFORMANCE (30% of the total score); and must use live accompaniment. Call time is 12:00NN. (Refer to Order the Parade for placement);
7. Excerpt, must be done in Rizal Elementary School Grounds before SAYAW SA KADALANAN and at Panabo Gym Grounds after SAYAW SA KADALANAN ONLY. A deduction of 1 point per 10seconds will be imposed for failure to follow;
8. SAYAW SA KADALANAN first dance exhibition will be at Rizal ES Ground, second stop is at Panabo Terminal fronting Petron Gasoline Station and the third and final stop is at fronting Sea oil Gasoline Station with minimum of 2 minutes and maximum of 3 minutes per exhibition;
9. Music should be live and not recorded. Electronic Instruments (i.e. guitars/acoustic guitar, keyboards, etc.) are not allowed;
10. Any authentic or creative costume/props are allowed as long as it's not vulgar and sexy;
11. Lifting, stunts and using of props are allowed as long as safety measures are in place. Props must be at least 6ft - 10ft in height;
12. Using of live animals is not allowed;
13. Time of performance must be seven (7) to ten (10) minutes, excluding entrance and exit. Time starts after the reading of the synopsis. A deduction of 1 point per 10 seconds will be sanctioned from the total score for under time and over time;
14. Preparation time per group is only 120 seconds;
15. Must submit the following to City Mayor's Office:
 - Entry Form;
 - Original School Certification duly signed by the School Head;
 - Photocopy of Identification Cards of all Members;
 - Parent Consent for minor members;
 - List of Performers (dancers musicians and props men);
 - Number of Instruments (i.e.: barrels, kulintang, etc.);
 - Description and sizes of main/set props;
 - Synopsis;

Deadline for the submission of the entries is on August 19, 2024 (Monday) 5:00PM at City Mayor's Office;

☞ **Group Coordinator and Choreographer/Artistic Director are needed and required to attend the Briefing and Orientation on August 27, 2024 (Tuesday) 1PM at Function Hall, 3F City Hall Building;**

16. Failure to attend will mean automatic disqualification and will no longer be allowed to perform during competition;
17. For concept and choreography clarifications, kindly contact City Mayor's Office at the given contact numbers;
18. Group picture will be posted at BINULIG FESTIVAL and TURISMO PANABO FB Page;
19. The committee will not be held liable for any physical damage and loss of property during the contest;
20. The decision of the judges is final, irrevocable, and therefore not appealable.
21. **The committee has the right to refuse or disqualify any contingent that deviates in the guidelines, from performing or an option to deduct 1 point per violation from the overall total of judge's score;**
22. **The Binulig Festival Committee and Technical Working Group will have any right for any changes of the posted Guidelines and Mechanics if needed and inform the participants ahead of time before the actual competition.**





- **Binulig Drum Bugle / Lyre Corps Showdown** | Time: 5:00PM – 10:00PM | Venue: Panabo Multi-Purpose Tourism Cultural and Sports Center

MECHANICS AND GUIDELINES:

1. The competition is open for Elementary, and Secondary Schools within Panabo City (Private and Public);
2. The Drum, Lyre and Bugle Corps Competition is an exhibition of performing drum Corps in their free interpretation of three musical pieces of their CHOICE: **1 Retro Music, 1 Novelty Song, 1 pop song and the Binulig Theme Song**;
3. The organizers will accept five (5) official entries per category;
4. Participating groups shall have a minimum of forty (40) but not more than seventy (70) performers inclusive of musical players/instrumentalists, majorettes, twirlers, and flag bearers;
5. All performers must be bona fide enrolled students of the school they represent and must submit a certification duly signed by the Principal or School Head;
6. Each group must join the SAYAW SA KADALANAN on October 10, 2023 – 1:30PM from Rizal Elementary School Grounds to the Panabo Multi-Purpose Tourism, Cultural and Sports Center for the 1st and 2nd judging of the STREET PERFORMANCE (30% of the total score); and must use live accompaniment. Call time is 12:00NN. (Refer to Order the Parade for placement);
7. Excerpt, must be done in Rizal Elementary School Grounds before SAYAW SA KADALANAN and at Panabo Gym Grounds after SAYAW SA KADALANAN ONLY. A deduction of 1 point per 10seconds will be imposed for failure to follow;
8. SAYAW SA KADALANAN first dance exhibition will be at Rizal ES Ground, second stop is at Panabo Terminal fronting Petron Gasoline Station and the third and final stop is at fronting Sea oil Gasoline Station with minimum of 2 minutes and maximum of 3 minutes per exhibition;
9. Competing groups are given 7-10 minutes performance inclusive of entrance and exit. A 3-point deduction shall be made on the group's total score for exceeding the time allotted. Official timers will be assigned to do the task;
10. A 2-minute allowance before and after the performance for the prop's ingress and egress;
11. Costumes of the participants, particularly the majorettes/twirlers, must be conformed to the accepted norms of decency and morality;
12. The use of party poppers, confetti, pyrotechnics and any other hazardous props are strictly prohibited;
13. Each competing group shall provide their respective props and materials for the performance and MUST conform to the capacity of the activity Area. Too huge props and/or materials too big to be admitted inside the activity area is/are strongly discouraged. It is the responsibility of each competing group to ferry/carry all the props and/or materials before and after the performance. As courtesy to the next performers, all competing groups must see to it that the performance area is ready for the next performers;
14. **The committee has the right to refuse or disqualify any contingent that deviates in the guidelines, from performing or an option to deduct 2 points from each of the judge's score;**

15. Fill up the entry form then submit it to City Mayor's Office. **Deadline for the submission of the entries is on August 19, 2024 (Monday) 5:00PM at City Mayor's Office;**
16. Group Coordinator and Choreographer/Artistic Director are needed and required to attend the Briefing and Orientation on August 27, 2024 (Tuesday) 1PM at Function Hall, 3F City Hall Building;
17. The decision of the panel of judges is final and irrevocable;
18. **The Binulig Festival Committee and Technical Working Group will have any right for any changes of the posted Guidelines and Mechanics if needed and inform the participants ahead of time before the actual competition;**
