Pursuant to DepEd Order No. 21 s. of 2019 re: Policy Guidelines on the K to 12 Basic Education Program, Alternative Delivery Modes (ADMs) are highlighted as one of the two main categories of Flexible Learning Options that is responsive to the needs, context, circumstances, and diversity of learners.

ADMs are instructional modalities that do not strictly follow the typical set-up for regular classroom instruction but follow the formal K to 12 curriculum in content. The flexibility in instructional or learning modalities of ADMs is in terms of the time and duration of instruction, the place of instruction, or the method of instruction.

This Office, therefore, instructs all public elementary and secondary schools to be ready to offer ADMs for all types of learners whenever the need arises. School Heads shall submit to the Office of the Schools Division Office through the Division ADM Focal, their ADM Implementation Plan for SY 2024-2025 until August 16, 2024.
