Date : August 2, 2024

This has reference to DOST-PAGASA ENSO Advisory dated July 12, 2024, which forecasts a high probability of La Niña development forming in August-September-October 2024 season and is likely to persist until the first quarter of 2025. With this development, the DOST-PAGASA ENSO Alert and Warning System is now raised to La Niña Alert.

Anent this, the Division Disaster Risk Reduction and Management is disseminating a **La Niña and Rainy Season Preparedness Plan** for the guidance of all schools and personnel to mitigate and prepare for the various hazards that accompany the said weather disturbance. Further, all schools are encouraged to establish local measures and enhance/update school contingency plans relative to the possible La Niña and Rainy Season.
