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The Department of Education (DepEd) continues to strengthen the culture of research and evidence-based decision-making in basic education. It issued DepEd Order 16, s. 2017, otherwise known as the Research Management Guidelines (RMG) and its amendment, DepEd Order No. 26, s. 2021, to establish a comprehensive framework for managing research, including the Basic Education Research Fund (BERF), and continues to encourage teachers and personnel to conduct research for policy and program development.

The Department recognizes the ~~importance~~ of action research in improving teaching and learning processes for quality education. Corollary to this, DepEd Order No. 47, s. 2017 also known as the Philippine Professional Standards for Teachers (PPST), particularly Domain 1, Strand 2, highlights the importance of research-based teaching and learning.

Consistent with these policies, the Department, in collaboration with the concluded Basic Education Sector Transformation (BEST) Program, developed a package for the discussion of action research particularly during LAC sessions. To maximize its use and incorporate updates on educational research practice, the Planning Service - Policy Research and Development Division (PS-PRDD) has updated the toolkit for use in general learning sessions/activities.

With this, this office hereby disseminates the Action Research Toolkit for research-related and other learning and development activities to aid teachers and researchers with basic concepts in conducting action research, provide a venue for sharing of action research practices, and utilize learning to improve teaching and learning processes.

These modules can be used through self-paced or self-directed learning as well as reference materials during the conduct of Learning Action Cell (LAC) and other learning sessions.
