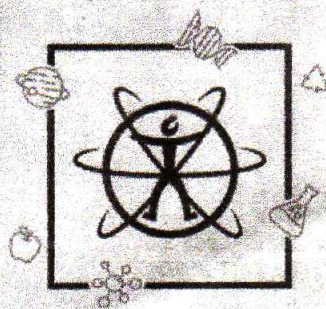

This year, our organization has selected two (2) student-leaders from each region all over the country to be a representative of their region and serve as a member of their respective Regional Councils.

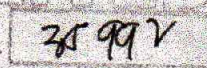

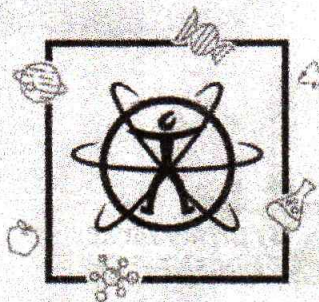

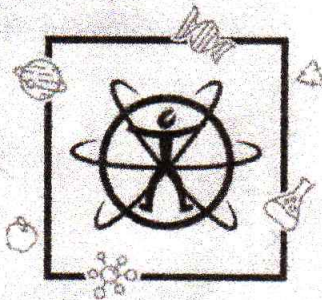

Philippine Society of Youth Science Clubs



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The **Philippine Society of Youth Science Clubs, Inc. (PSYSC)** is not only a prominent organization of science clubs within the Philippines, but also the largest umbrella organization of science clubs in Southeast Asia, duly recognized as the premier organization that promotes its thrust of Public Understanding of Science, Technology, and the Environment (ST&E).

Composed of volunteers from top universities in the Philippines, the organization has been conducting national and regional events for over 120,000 affiliate members from all over the country, examples of these being:

The National Youth Science, Technology, and Environment Science Camp (NYSTESC), a four (4) day camp, conducted every July, for high school science club members and their advisers. It tackles a specific field in science, technology and the environment (ST&E), aiming to provide awareness about such topic and encouraging them to learn and appreciate ST&E more outside the four corners of the classroom;

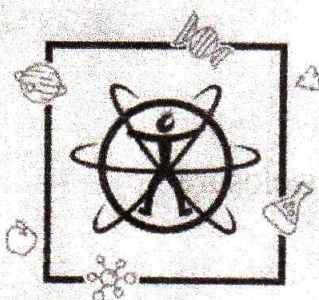
The National Leadership Enhancement and Development (NLEAD) Program, is a training-seminar for selected high school science clubbers who would compose the PSYSC Regional Councils (RCs) in their respective regions throughout the country. NLEAD aims to empower the RCs and enhance their knowledge and leadership skills to enable them to implement activities that will reach our affiliates in the grassroots.

National Children's Science Interactive Workshop (NCSIW), same as NYSTESC, it is a four day camp which focuses on a specific topic in ST&E and aims to give an alternative venue for students to learn and appreciate ST&E more. However, NCISW is for elementary science club members and teachers and is conducted every December.

Search for the Most Outstanding Science Clubs (SEARCH), an event wherein the accomplishments and contributions made by certain science clubs to the community will be recognized. It serves as a bridge to train young minds to become the future leaders through encouraging the students to develop relevant practical projects to which their community can benefit;

a seminar-workshop called **Beginners' Learning and Appreciation of Science and Technology (BLAST)** which introduces science clubbing to elementary and secondary schools.

Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics Expo (STEM Expo) for senior high school students which is a two-day series of competitions and exhibits showcasing innovative ideas and groundbreaking advances in the field of STEM.



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The PSYSC also celebrates the **National Science Club Month (NSCM)** during September through the:

National Science Clubs Summit (SUMMIT), a two (2) day camp for high school students, held simultaneously in several regions in the Philippines to make the celebration of NSCM accessible to more affiliates in the different regions of the Philippines;

I Teach Science Seminar (ITSS), a half-day activity composed of lectures, workshops and discussions that will provide new learning and teaching techniques for high school teachers in a field in ST&E. It is open to all science club advisers who will participate in SUMMIT.

PSYSC Science Olympiad (PSO), an inter-school national science quiz competition, open for both elementary and high school students. The PSO eliminations are held at different SUMMIT sites. Afterwards, the top 20 schools nationwide for each bracket will proceed to the PSO final round, which is conducted at the National Capital Region; and

MathSciAko which is a Luzon-based activity composed of several engineering science challenges and interactive workshops. The competition is composed of two brackets: Bracket I and II which is for Elementary and High school students, respectively.

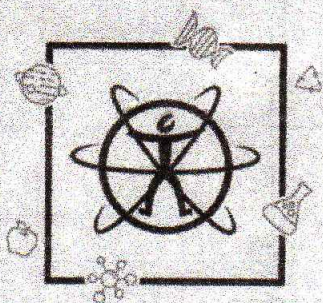
Science Clubbing since 1971

The inception of the Philippine Society of Youth Science Clubs, Inc. traces back to March 5, 1971, when 25 participants of the National Science Fair together with a Philippine Science High School student, forged a friendship circle that birthed an extraordinary initiative. This collective, then called the National Science Club of the Philippines, organized the inaugural National Youth Science Camp (CAMP) at UP Los Baños, marking the beginning of a journey and history. The organization has since grown into the PSYSC we know today, and currently, it proudly counts over a hundred thousand affiliated science clubbers all over the country.

Upholding Science Clubbing Advocacies

*We promote leadership through programs such as **PSYSC Medal of Excellence** and **Search for the Most Outstanding Science Club (SEARCH)**. Science Promotion is done through our **CATALYST**, PSYSC's official publication and **Beginners' Learning and Appreciation of Science and Technology (BLAST)**.*

*We advocate science education through our **PSYSC Journal** and **Online Educational supplements** for teachers.*



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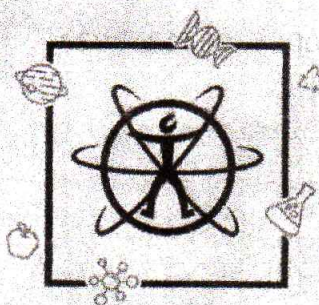
