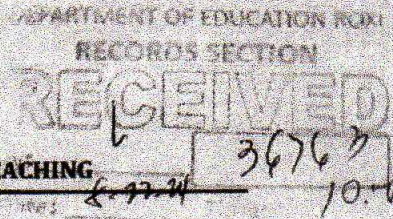

The MATATAG Agenda was launched as the new direction of the Department of Education (DepEd) towards improving the quality of basic education in the country.

In realizing one of the components of the MATATAG Agenda, the Policy Guidelines on the Implementation of the MATATAG Curriculum has been issued through DepEd Order No. 010, series of 2024, providing context and directions and articulating its features, designs, and standards.

The Policy is clear in its scope, articulating that *the MATATAG Curriculum shall serve as the fundamental blueprint for teachers at the classroom level, help instructional leaders create supervisory and management plans to oversee instructional delivery, provide appropriate technical and other forms of assistance to teachers and school heads, and monitor learning gains, and that parents and other external education stakeholders shall be given direction and opportunity to support the MATATAG Curriculum in achieving its goals.*

Cognizant of the policy's scope, this Office directs all DepEd Regional Offices to reiterate to the Schools Division Offices and schools within their jurisdiction the need to devise measures in which MATATAG Curriculum, through its **Learning Area Grade Level and Performance Standards**, is communicated among all stakeholders (e.g. parents, teachers, learners). Activities that may be conducted include orientations, fora, conferences, among others. This is essential for garnering support from all stakeholders in the implementation of the MATATAG Curriculum. Refer to the Annex for a sample communication plan.

Additionally, all secondary schools are reminded to organize Career Guidance activities for the school year 2024-2025. These activities are crucial for preparing learners to make informed life and career decisions.
