Date : July 31, 2024

The National Educators Academy of the Philippines (NEAP) in collaboration with the Bureau of Learning Delivery-Teaching and Learning Division (BLD-TLD), through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD) and Human Resource Development Division (HRDD), will conduct a Hybrid Training for Senior High School - Technical Vocational Livelihood (SHS-TVL) and Junior High School Technical Vocational Education (JHS-TVE) teachers on Trainer's Methodology 1 (TM1) on August 12, 2024 to September 13, 2024 at the Ritz Hotel at Garden Oases, F. Portas St., Bo. Obrero St. Davao City. This training encompasses competencies required of a Technical- Vocational Trainer to perform the tasks in the areas of session planning, instructional delivery/facilitation, competency assessment, and maintenance of training resources/facilities.

The Hybrid TM1 Training is slated on the following dates:

- c. September 4-13, 2024 (10 days face to face content input and demonstration/return demonstration, and checking/enhancement/ consolidation of portfolio, preparation for assessment; and TM1 National Assessment) participants should be at the venue on September 3, 2024 pm with dinner as the first meal, and with pm snack on September 13, 2024 as the last meal to be served.

The activity aims to:

- a. Enhance the knowledge, skills, positive attitude and work values of the teacher in accordance with the prevailing standards in the Technical and Vocational Education and Training (TVET) sector;
- b. support more teachers to acquire at least TM1 Certificate;
- c. prepare teachers to become Accredited National Competency Assessors.

The participants in this training are the Division-recommended teachers who have met the criteria set forth in the memorandum DM-OUHROD-2024-0313. The list is found in the annex.

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Participants are required to bring the following:

- a. Laptop;
- b. Extension cord;
- c. Not expired National Certificate (NCE);
- d. Letter of intent;
- e. Notarized MOA; and
- f. Approved Authority to Travel.

Board and lodging, supplies and materials, registration/training cost, and assessment fee of the participants shall be charge to the downloaded BLD-TLD Funds, all subject to the usual auditing rules and regulations.

The participants are entitled to service credits in accordance with DO 53, s. 2003 "Granting of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers" when the training falls on Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays. The School Division Offices are highly encouraged to support the participation of their representatives in this activity.

To ensure no disruption of classes, teaching loads of the participants shall be taken care of by the TVL/TVE colleague.
