In pursuit to achieving quality teaching, teachers' professional development is a must. The evidence is clear that direct systematic instruction in phonics during the early years of schooling is an essential foundation for teaching children to read. Findings from the research evidence indicate that all students learn best when teachers adopt an integrated approach to reading that explicitly teaches phonemic awareness, phonics, fluency, vocabulary knowledge and comprehension.

In line to DepEd Panabo's mantra: Empowering Champions in Education through Journeying, Blending and Fostering commitment in providing quality education MATATAG for all, this office conducts professional development conduit to the University of the Philippines-Ugnayan ng Pahinungod called E-GURO, a short course for Kinder to Grade 3 teachers on **September 23-October 23, 2024**.

The E-Guro aims to strengthen the capacity of the K to 3 teachers in literacy and numeracy through a series of regular professional development activities. The E-Guro Introductory Course in Teaching K to 3 Learners: A Journey to Early Childhood Education is a free learning course with four modules on literacy, numeracy, early childhood education, and special education.
