RATIONALE

Special Education (SPED) is a set of educational programs and/or services designed to address the needs of learners with disabilities through educational plans and instruments that will bring them to the highest level of their potential and capacity (Handbook for SPED, 1987 as cited in Department Order No. 44, Series 2021). The said DO 44 stated, among other things, that all teachers shall be considered primary implementers of inclusive education, which includes special education. As such, they shall possess the proper values, perspectives, attitudes, and competencies that communicate and reflect inclusion as they address the educational needs of diverse learners.

Based on the research on Integrated Development between Davao del Norte State College and Department of Education Schools Division of Panabo conducted, teachers revealed moderate level (mode=48.65%) of capability in terms of designing, adapting, and implementing teaching strategies that are responsiveness to learners with disabilities, giftedness, and talents and moderate level (mode=45.95%) of priority area to be addressed (Junsay et al. I Terminal Report, 2022). To address this, change projects were approved and adopted by the participating schools as part of the Integrated Development Program for Basic Education Institutions (IDP-BEI) and endorsed to appropriate bodies for support in any form through Resolution No. 01, Series 2022, dated August 11, 2022.

One of the change projects aims to improve teachers' teaching capability, and it is named the Capacitating Teachers Training Series on Teaching Strategies for Special Education. Thus, this extension project is proposed.

OBJECTIVES

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This extension project aims to skill teachers in teaching strategies, specifically in designing, adapting, and implementing teaching strategies for learners with disabilities, giftedness, and talents.
