

2. All interested schools shall submit an endorsement duly signed by the Principal or the School Head to be submitted to the City Anti-Drug Abuse Council (CADAC) Office, located in Panabo Public Market on or before **November 6, 2024**. Entries submitted after the set deadline will not be entertained.
3. The contestants of the different categories must be a bonafide student of the school they are representing and are currently enrolled in the said school.
4. Each participating school per department can submit only one (1) entry.
5. There shall be a minimum of **six (6) and a maximum of ten (10) performers**. This number includes the other personalities who shall be on stage during the performance (e.g propsmen, etc.)
6. Each entry shall be in-line with the activity the National Drug Prevention Week (Anti-Illegal Drug Campaign of the Government).
7. In this activity, contestants must have/provide a **video** of the dance since this activity is done through virtual wherein the name of the school, participants, and its category (either Junior High, Senior High and College) will be shown to the introductory part of the video and shall submit the video copy file saved in USB Flahsdrive on or before **November 11, 2024 to the CADAC Office until 5:00 PM**. The latter will be posted through the Facebook page City Anti-Drug Abuse Council-Panabo City FB Page on **November 13, 2024**. The participants must provide their own instruments. Failure to submit entries/video file will lead to disqualification.
8. Each category/group is free to use foreign or Original Pilipino Music (OPM) of any genre whether old or any of the latest songs. This is to provide each entry with more artistic freedom in conceptualizing its entry.
9. Narration is strictly not allowed. This competition is designed for each entry to tell a story revolving around the said activity through interpretative dancing.
10. No dangerous props/stunts are allowed.
11. The performance shall not exceed to seven (7) minutes but less than five (5) minutes.
12. For this allotted time, each group is free to delete, cut, insert and jumble the songs chosen.
13. Any time in excess of the allowed performance time shall be personalized by deducting point/s from all of the judge's scores in his manner:
1-10 seconds = 1 percentage point
11-30 seconds = 2 percentage points
31-60 seconds = 3 percentage points
61-90 seconds = 4 percentage points
91-120 seconds = 5 percentage points
