Attached is Memorandum OM-OUOPS-2024-06587, re: Supplementary Guidelines On The Authority To Use Framework Agreement For The Procurement Of Response Interventions Under FY 2024 Disaster Preparedness And Response Program Funds.

This Office through the Bids and Awards Committee, advises schools and DepEd offices to use the framework agreement for the procurement of response interventions in anticipation of disasters and/or emergencies. Procuring entities may use framework agreement, as a contractual agreement in procuring goods and services as defined under Section 5(h) and 5@ of Republic Act 9184.

Further, RA 12009, or the New Government Procurement Act states that the framework agreement is a procurement strategy to expand the pool of prospective bidders, take advantage of economies of scale, minimize the administrative burden of conducting separate procurement activities, and generate time and money savings.

PREPAREDNESS AND RESPONSE PROGRAM FUNDS**

DATE : August 15, 2024

To ensure immediate and timely provision of response interventions to the affected schools, the Office of the Undersecretary for Operations through the Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Service (DRRMS) **authorizes schools and DepEd offices to use framework agreement for the procurement of response interventions for in anticipation of disasters and/or emergencies.**

Procuring entities **may use framework agreement, as a contractual arrangement,** in the procurement of goods and services as defined under Section 5(h) and 5(r) of Republic Act 9184.

Further, R.A 12009 or the New Government Procurement Act states that the **framework agreement is a procurement strategy to expand the pool of prospective bidders,** take advantage of economies of scale, minimize the administrative burden of conducting separate procurement activities, and generate time and money savings.

This shall be in the nature of an option contract between the Procuring Entity and the bidder that stipulates the terms and conditions that would be applied in subsequent contracts for the procurement of Goods, Infrastructure Projects, and Consulting Services with a single or multiple contractor, manufacturer, supplier, distributor, consultant, and service provider.

With this, **all schools and DepEd offices are advised to use this procurement strategy to ensure timely provision of response interventions.**
