1. Mechanics of the IP Games/Laro ng Lahi

Conduct of Regional ALS- IPEd Day: KALUDUK

Date: October 28-30, 2024

Venue: Jose Timbol Central Elementary School, Sta. Maria, Davao Occidental

Here are the mechanics and sample sizes/descriptions of materials for some of the Recreational Tribal Games listed for the ALS IE Launching:

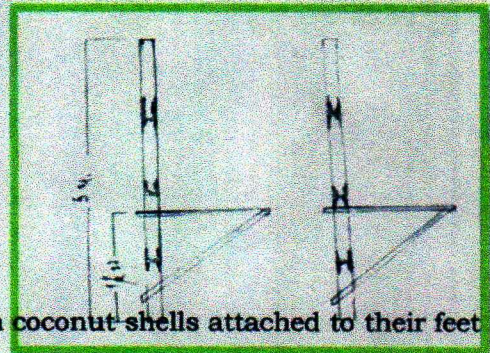
1. Kadang-Kadang/Karang/Tiyakad (Bamboo/wooden Stilt Relay)

Mechanics:

- Participants will race on bamboo/wooden stilts over a marked course.
- Each team will consist of 5 members male or female.
- The race can be done in relays or individual sprints.
- Participants must maintain balance while walking on the stilts; falling means they must start from the last checkpoint.
- The first team or individual to reach the finish line wins.

Materials and Description:

1. Each division will bring its own set of Karang (Bamboo/wooden Stilt) with spare based on the given description.



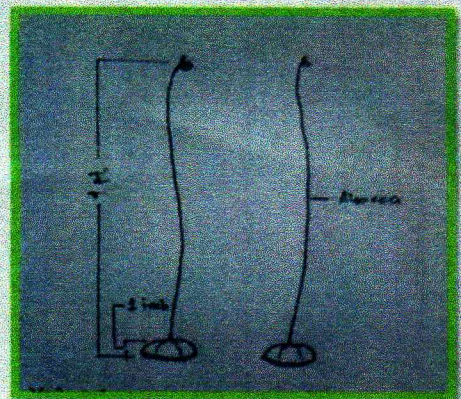
2. Kadang sa Bagol (Coconut Shell Relay)

Mechanics:

- Participants will walk or run while balancing on coconut shells attached to their feet with strings.
- Each team will consist of 5 members.
- Similar to the bamboo stilt race, participants must traverse a marked course.
- Falling off the coconut shells requires starting from the last checkpoint.
- The race can be done individually or in relay teams.
- The fastest participant or team wins.

Materials and Description:

1. Each division will bring its own set of Kadang sa bagol (coconut shell) with spare based on the given description.
2. Using an abaca fiber cord is highly encouraged.



3. Human Basketball using a Basket or Bukag as the Ring



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Mechanics:

- Each team must have or consist of 5 members.
- A human basket (One participant holding a basket (bukag) at the back) stands at a designated spot or may run away from the opponent to avoid the ball once they will throw it towards the basket.
- Other team members attempt to throw balls into the basket (bukag) from a marked distance.
- Teams have a set time limit to score as many "baskets" as possible.
- The team with the most baskets scored within the time limit wins.

4. Labu-labo (Dodge Ball)

Mechanics:

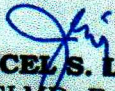
- Two teams face off in a traditional dodgeball game.
- Players try to hit opponents with a soft ball (made of coconut twigs) while avoiding getting hit themselves.
- Once a player is hit, they are out unless a teammate catches a ball thrown by the opposing team.
- The team that eliminates all players on the opposing side wins.

5. Native Chicken Catching/Hunting

Mechanics:

- A designated area is set up with obstacles where chickens are released.
- Participants must catch the chickens using only their hands.
- The game can be done individually or in teams.
- The participant or team that catches the most chickens within the time limit wins.
