

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2023 DIVISION ASEAN QUIZ BEE MECHANICS

1. Student participants must be currently in Grades 9, ages between 14 – 16 years old, and willing to participate in the Regional ASEAN Quiz Bee.
2. Contestants should wear their respective school uniforms and bring their ballpen.
3. Coaches are required to submit 3 questions (1 – easy; 1 – average 1 – difficult and 1 - clincher question to be used during the competition, to this email account john.visillas@deped.gov.ph on October 29, 2024, no later than 3:00 in the afternoon. Late submission means non-inclusion of the questions during the contest. Questions should follow this format: Question/Level/Answer/Reference.
4. Questions will be taken from the provided Reviewer and the ASEAN website.
5. The quiz bee is in written form. Contestants will be given the test questions. They are only given 30 seconds per item to answer the question. Students should write in CAPITAL letter their answers on a separate sheet, or compute the solution on separate paper to get the correct answer.
6. If the participant wants to change his answer, he should cross out his answer.
7. The following are the points of each category of questions: Easy – 1 pts; Average 2 pts and Difficult – 3 pts.
8. In case of a tie, five (5) questions will be given to the participants, whoever will get the highest score will be declared as the winner.

The Schools Division Superintendents, Assistant Schools Division Superintendents, Chief Education Supervisors and Curriculum and Learning Management Division CLMD personnel are encouraged to take part in the activity.

Further, all participants are encouraged to wear the national attire of any member-countries of the Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN) or United Nations (UN). In the absence of such attire, any accent or accessories related to the chosen country may be worn during the whole duration of the activity. It is suggested that they will be at the venue a day before the contest proper for the informational visit to ASEAN-UNESCO affiliated offices/institutions within the city.

For the student-participants must meet the following requirements:

- a. Currently enrolled in Grade 9, between 14-16 years old;
- b. Have a grade of 85 and above in Araling Panlipunan during the first quarter of School Year 2024-2025;
- c. Have good interpersonal skills/ good team player;
- d. Willing (with parental consent) to travel to any parts of the country, in case there will be a national competition relative to ASEAN; and
- e. Physically fit.



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Participants shall be entitled to service credits in accordance with DepEd Order 53, s. 2003 entitled: Updated Guidelines on the Grant of Vacation Service Credits to Teachers and Compensatory Time-Off (CTO) as per Civil Service Commission (CSC) and Department of Budget and Management (DBM) Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004 on Non-Monetary Remuneration for Overtime Service Rendered for the non-teaching personnel.


