




The Career Executive Service Board (CESB) will hold the 51st Founding Anniversary and 2024 CES Lifelong Learning for Leadership Congress (2024 CESCON) from 5-6 November 2024 at the Philippine International Convention Center, with the theme "*Pag-Ibig sa Bayan, CESerbyong may Dangal.*"

The 2024 CESCON program includes the oath-taking of newly appointed Career Executive Service Officers (CESOs) and newly conferred CES eligibles, the commencement ceremony for the graduates of the Leadership and Management Proficiency (LAMP) Program, the Annual Tribute to retiring CES members, among others.


The CESCON also serves as a learning and networking forum to reassess, redefine and reaffirm the institutional and historical significance, strategic roles, and the unifying power and potentials of the CES in shaping the national consciousness and in leading the nation at the forefront of governance, development and nation building for the future.

All CES officers, eligibles and on-stream candidates for CES eligibility are authorized to attend the 51st CESCON on official business pursuant to CESB Resolution No. 81 s.1992.

The CESCON registration fee is TWELVE THOUSAND PESOS (₱12,000.00) per participant inclusive of meals, training kit, and certificate. Register on or before 15 October 2024, to take advantage of the early bird registration fee of TEN THOUSAND PESOS (₱10,000.00). Participants may charge the registration fee, hotel accommodation, and travel expenses against the funds of their respective agencies in accordance with existing policies of the Department of Budget and Management and the Commission on Audit.
