ELEMENTARY CATEGORY MODERN FOLK DANCE CONTEST

MECHANICS:

- This contest is open to all **Elementary Schools** in Panabo City.
- A total number of **8 slots** shall be catered on a **first come first serve basis**.
- Each group should consist of a **minimum of 10 and maximum of 15 elementary pupils** including propsmen. There will be 3 points deduction to the final average if there are excess or deficient in number of participants.
- The dance is **open with a Fiesta type of Philippine Folk Dance** and the participating group is **free to use any Philippine Folk Dance music**.
- The team is allowed to **combine a number of Philippine Folk Dances** creatively.
- Staging must be implemented and the team is allowed to **modify the music, dance steps and costumes**.
- Each group is free to delete, cut, insert and jumble their music as long as it is in conformity to their assigned performances.
- The performance time will be limited to a minimum of **5** and a maximum of **7 minutes** per entry. Lack or excess on the required time duration will result to deduction of 3 points to the final average.
- Each group should choose their own costumes. **Costumes must not be violent or dangerous** in any way. It must not contain pointed objects that may possibly inflict harm on the others and the members themselves.
- **Costumes must be decent**. They must not attract malice in any way thus, revealing outfits are not allowed.
- Use of props will be allowed as long as it **will not cause any delay** in the program and any harm to the performance of other groups. Props such as oil, fire, confetti, pyrotechnic gadgets, smoke generators or combustible material, broken glass, live animals, sharp objects and the like are prohibited.
- **Judges' decision is final and irrevocable**.

- **Costumes must be decent**. They must not attract malice in any way thus, revealing outfits are not allowed.
