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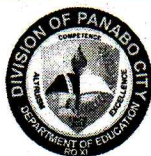
EVENTS AND SKILLS GUIDELINES

Event	Rules and Mechanics
Arabic Language and Islamic Values Education Oration (Nasechah)	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The contestant must be in grade 5 (male or female) and eleven (10-11) years old enrolled during the SY 2023-24. 2. Shall be given 5-7 minutes including preparation in expressing his/her thoughts relevant to the Muslim culture, traditions and practices. Further, he/she will get a deduction of one(1) point from the total score for every minute in excess of the allotted time. 3. May choose English or Filipino as a medium of delivery but recite "Adillah"(evidences) from the Quran and Hadith in Arabic Language. 4. Wear Jubah/Thawb for male and Abaya for female with head hijab and tutub.
Harf Touch	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The contestant must be in grade 2 ages seven to eight enrolled during the SY2023-2024. 2. Pronounce the Arabic letters correctly with speed and accuracy (blind-folded learner-participant). 3. Seated at the designated area in order not to see the process undergone by the contestant on stage. 4. Take turns on stage to identify the 28 letters engraved/cut on illustration board within one (1) minute.
Quran Reading	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The contestant must be in grades 6 ages twelve to thirteen (12-13) and officially enrolled for SY 2023-2024. 2. Read and recite the verse (Ayah)/chapter (surah) with proper Tajweed, and clear voice in Tawasot/read the surah or ayah in tawasot within five(5) minutes.. 3. Seated at the designated area in order not to see the process undergone by the contestant on stage. 4. Wait for the panel of judges to choose the surah to be read. 5. Bring a copy of the Holy Quran. 6. Wear proper attire (black abayah and white kombong/hijab for female and kimon with totob/kopya for male). 7. Seat on the floor with the book stand and use the microphone in the actual reading of the selected surah.
