The Department of Education Regional Office XI through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division announces the conduct of 2024 RSTF with the theme *"Towards a Shared Vision: Exploring the Future for a Better Tomorrow"* on November 28-30, 2024 at Nabunturan National Comprehensive High School, Poblacion, Nabunturan, Davao de Oro.
2. The Regional Science and Technology Fair serves as a platform for students to showcase innovative research projects that foster critical thinking and problem-solving skills through hands-on research. This event enhances scientific communication abilities while providing valuable networking opportunities with fellow young scientists. Secondary level winners (Rank 1) in all individual and team categories will advance to represent the region at the National Science and Technology Fair (NSTF) in March 2025.
3. The 2024 Regional Science and Technology Fair will feature Ranks 1 and 2 winners from the Division Science and Technology Fair (DSTF) across all categories, subject to approval by the Regional Scientific Review Committee. No substitutions will be permitted. In a new initiative to cultivate early scientific inquiry, elementary level students (Ranks 1 and 2) in both individual and team research categories will participate up to the regional level only, providing them valuable exposure to scientific research methodology and presentation. Their participation concludes at the regional fair, while secondary level winners will proceed to national competition.
4. Participants, coaches, Regional Scientific Review Committee (RSRC), and other members of the working committees are found in the enclosures and shall be entitled to service credits in accordance with DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003 entitled Updated Guidelines on the Grant of Vacation Service Credits to teachers. However, non-teaching personnel including management Staff shall be given Compensatory Time-Off (CTO) per Civil Service Commission (CSC) and Department of Budget and Management (DBM) Joint Circular No.2, s. 2024 on Non-Monetary Remuneration for Overtime Service Rendered, specific attention on Section 5.
5. Submit the **printed official division entries** on November 11-15, 2024 with an **endorsement** by the Schools Division Superintendent and **report of the conduct of DSTF** at RO XI-CLMD office.
