November 11, 2024

In light of the **Tropical Cyclone Bulleting No. 14** on Typhoon (TY) Nika, issued by the Philippine Atmospheric, Geophysical and Astronomical Services Administration (PAGASA) as of November 11, 2024, at 2:00 pm, the typhoon's location was last estimated near Lagawe, Ifugao. Additionally, Tropical Depression (TD) *Ofel*, currently outside the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR), is expected to enter on November 12, 2024, with possible landfall in Northern Luzon between November 14-16, 2024. Due to these weather conditions, the in-person gathering in Ilocos Norte for National Students' Day 2024 will be suspended.

To ensure the safety and well-being of all participants, guests, DepEd personnel, and other stakeholders, the activities for the National Students' Day will be conducted through a **Virtual Session on November 16-17, 2024**. Please refer to **Annex A for the indicative program of activities**.

All Regional Federation Supreme Secondary Learner Government (RFSSLG) Officers are requested to join the event. The online platform link will be communicated through the Regional and Division Youth Formation Coordinator a day before the virtual sessions.
