

This refers to the findings of the Government Assistance and Subsidies Service (GASS) on multiple Learner Reference Number (LRN) created in the Learner Information System (LIS).

In 2023, GASS established a monitoring mechanism to ensure that the information stated in the billing statement of private schools matches with the information provided in the LIS, such as the LRN, complete name, grade level, and current school.

For this year, upon receipt of the billing statements at the central office, GASS manually checks the LRNs of learners in the LIS.

Through this process, GASS discovered that several learners appear to have multiple LRNs.

The issuance of multiple LRNs poses a significant risk particularly concerning the allocation of educational funding, student enrollment statistics, and the accurate distribution of resources to schools and learners.

This practice also defrauds the government in terms of subsidy distribution and release. In relation to this, we respectfully request you to be circumspect in approving request for new LRNs and ensure that request for new LRNs will only be approved after due evaluation, validation.
