Teacher-coaches are also entitled to claim service credits on rehearsals that falls on holidays, Saturdays and Sundays. DTR should be signed by the school principal prior to submission to the Education Program Supervisor for MAPEH, Ramil Jacky P. Firman.

The school principal is advised to oversee the preparations and scheduling of rehearsals, including the classes of teachers involved to abide with the existing policy and mandates of the Department of Education.

In addition to the competitions, Musikahan sa Tagum 2025 will feature an array of exciting events, including:


