Greetings from MATH-Inic Philippines, a partner of Institute for the Advancement of Vedic Mathematics, a British registered charity dedicated to the furtherance of Vedic Mathematics (VM) worldwide!

We in MATH-Inic Philippines have been promoting the techniques of mental arithmetic of the Vedic Math system in schools nationwide since 2011. Our aim is to reduce our learners' reliance on smart phones and other calculating devices and to develop deeper appreciation of Mathematics by showing that those arithmetic techniques also apply in higher Math like Algebra, Trigonometry and Calculus.

We have also coordinated the participation of the Philippines in International Vedic Mathematics Olympiad (IVMO) which resulted in the Filipinos lording it over the competitors from ten other countries, winning 75% of the total awards given in the initial competition in 2021, 90% in 2022, 95% in 2023 and 97% in 2024.

Judging from the results of the international Olympiads, we can say that our teachers have been quite successful in supplementing our current school curriculum with Vedic Math. To help us introduce VM to more students and maintain our dominance in the international Vedic Math circle, we are inviting your teachers to join us in our **FREE** six session **Vedic Math Basics** webinars on Saturday and Sunday afternoons at 4:00 to 6:00 PM from January 25 to Feb 9, 2025.

These webinars also aim to prepare the teachers to take the IAVM assessments and to train their students to participate in the local and international events scheduled this year which are listed in the Annex below.
