This has reference to Regional Memorandum ESSD-2025-019 that reiterates the implementation of the programs of Oplan Kalusugan sa Department of Education (OK sa DepEd) by setting targets on health services rendered pursuant to DepEd Order No. 28, s. 2018.

Medical, dental, nursing and nutritional services must be available to all learners in all grade level, teaching and non-teaching personnel. The following are the suggested targets every school year but not limited to:

All health personnel are mandated to conduct the health services and activities in schools in coordination with the school head for the schedule of activities and services, and no disruption of classes shall be strictly implemented. Medical and dental health



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personnel are encouraged to visit classrooms during MAPEH period especially in Health Education for the conduct of medical and dental services.

Updating of accomplishment report for medical, dental, and nursing services shall be on or before the 10th day of the succeeding month of the quarter using SHD Form 5 template sent to Group Chats, other OK sa DepEd accomplishment reports shall be updated and submitted based on the agreed deadline by the focal persons.

Division health personnel are encouraged to conduct health services at least three (3) times a week. Travelling and other incidental expenses shall be charged against local/downloaded funds subject to the usual auditing and accounting rules and regulations.

REGIONAL TARGETS FOR OPLAN KALUSUGAN SA DEPED

To: Assistant Regional Director
Schools Division Superintendents
Chiefs of Functional Divisions
All Others Concerned

1. Pursuant to the Policy and Guidelines of the Oplan Kalusugan sa Department of Education or DepEd Order No. 28, s. 2018, the Department of Education Region XI reiterates to strengthen the implementation of the programs of Oplan Kalusugan sa Department of Education (OK sa DepEd) by setting targets on health services rendered.

2. Medical, dental, nursing and nutritional services must be available to all learners in all grade level, teaching and non-teaching personnel. The following are the targets every school year but not limited to:

- 30% of schools visited and monitored (OKD programs) and health education conducted by health personnel in areas of assignment
- 30% Kindergarten to Grade 12 are physically examined prioritizing SBFP beneficiaries
- 80% teaching and non-teaching personnel are physically examined
- Height and Weight Assessment:
 - 90% of Kindergarten to Grade 6 learners
 - 80% of Grade 7-12 learners
- Vision and Auditory screening:
 - 30% of Kindergarten learners
- Psychosocial Risk Assessment
 - 5% of enrolled Grades 4 to 6 learners
 - 5% of enrolled Grades 7 to 12 learners
- Treatment:

Medical Officers:

-100% of learners, teaching and non-teaching personnel with ailments are treated and/or referred when necessary to higher centers/health facilities.

Nurses:

-100% of learners, teaching and non-teaching personnel with ailments are treated and/or referred when necessary.



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Dentists:

- 40% Preventive and curative treatment to Kinder to Grade 3 prioritizing SBFP beneficiaries.
- 10% of Grades 4 to 12 learners who need preventive and curative treatment are treated and or referred prioritizing SBFP beneficiaries.
- 50% of Kinder to Grade 12 have undergone Oral examination prioritizing SBFP beneficiaries.

- 10% of secondary/elementary schools have established of Learner Support Centers (LSCs)/AFFs that will provide services for OKD Health and Wellness Programs (ARH, Mental Health and NDEP).
- 10% established teen centers/LSCs are certified as Adolescent-Friendly Facilities
- 10% of schools have referral system with AFFs/Learner Support Centers to cater the needs of adolescent learners
- 25% of schools are validated for WinS implementation prioritizing WinS 3 stars' schools.
- 5% of schools improve in WinS implementation
- 6- Advocacy campaign/engagement conducted in relation to the 6 OKD Flagship programs and other DOH/other agencies activities
