This annual initiative recognizes exemplary public servants who have demonstrated excellence, dedication, and integrity in the performance of their duties.

We invite all government offices, including national agencies, local government units, government-owned or controlled corporations, and state universities and colleges, to participate by nominating deserving individuals and groups who exemplify the highest standards of public service.

Categories of Awards:

- 1. Presidential Lingkod Bayan Award** – is conferred to an individual or group **comprised of five members** for exceptional or extraordinary contributions resulting from an idea or performance that had nationwide impact on public interest, security and patrimony.
- 2. CSC Pagasa Award** – is conferred to an individual or group **comprised of five members** for outstanding contribution/s resulting from an idea or performance that directly benefit more than one department of the government.
- 3. Dangal ng Bayan Award** – conferred to an individual for performance of an extraordinary act or public service and consistent demonstration of exemplary ethical behavior on the basis of observance of the eight norms provided under Republic Act No. 6713.

All officials and employees in the career and non-career service of the government, including appointive and elective officials, are eligible for nomination. Nominees must meet the criteria of the specific award category and must not have been found guilty of any administrative or criminal offense.
