

Pursuant to Regional Memorandum No. CLMD-2025-129 regarding the implementation of the Alternative Delivery Mode (ADM) during in-house athletic or academic training, this Office directs school heads to implement measures that ensure continuity of learning for students participating in in-house athletic or academic training, as well as for learners whose teachers are attending seminars or training, in the exigency of service.

This directive shall be carried out every time there is an in-house athletic or academic training or when teachers attend seminars or training. Submission of a Learning and Service Continuity Plan (LSCP) outlining the specific measures to be implemented shall be required prior to the issuance of the Authority to Travel.

Public Schools District Supervisors and Learning Area Supervisors are tasked to monitor and ensure compliance with this directive.

Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is highly desired.

**ALTERNATIVE DELIVERY MODE (ADM) DURING IN-HOUSE
ATHLETIC OR ACADEMIC TRAINING**

To: Schools Division Superintendents

1. Relative to the commitment of the Department of Education to providing quality and accessible education to all, including disadvantaged learners, at risk of dropping out, in emergencies, and those who are undergoing in-house athletic or academic training, such as for the Davao Region Athletic Association (DAVRAA) Meet, Regional Festival of Talents (RFOT) and Regional Schools Press Conference (RSPC), this Office requires all Schools Division Offices to ensure continuity of learning, hence, the following measures must be done during the conduct of the in-house athletic or academic training at the SDO level:

a. the Curriculum and Instruction Division (CID) and the SDO Sports Office shall collaboratively design a Learning and Service Continuity Plan (LCSP) that ensures continuity of learning and service during the in-house athletic or academic training;

b. complete copies of the SLMs across learning areas shall be provided to the learners;

c. sufficient time in a day shall be spared for the learners to continue learning through the SLMs;

d. there shall be a teacher at the in-house training who shall handle the provision and retrieval of SLMs, and their submission to the respective class advisers and subject teachers; and

e. other analogous actions that are deemed necessary to ensure the continuity of learning within the training.

2. This policy shall also apply to learners whose teachers attend seminars or training, in the exigency of service.

3. In view of this, the SDO shall forward a copy of the LCSP to the Office of the Regional Director, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division.

4. The CLMD shall monitor and evaluate the SDOs' compliance with this Memorandum.

5. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum to the concerned is desired.
