REITERATION OF THE PREVENTIVE MEASURES ON MPOX

1. Attached is Regional Memorandum No. ESSD-2025-157 dated June 10, 2025, re: "REITERATION OF THE PREVENTIVE MEASURES FOR MPOX" acknowledging the risk for MPOX in the Region and the need for the public to know the common signs and symptoms and its preventive measures.
2. With this, all public schools are directed to observe the following precautions, to wit:
 - a. practice good hand hygiene – ensure access to handwashing facilities with soap or sanitizers;
 - b. sanitizing frequently touched surfaces;
 - c. monitoring symptoms;
 - d. avoiding close contact with sick persons;
 - e. quarantining/isolating person with contagious diseases; and
 - f. seeking immediate consultation.
3. Further, all public schools shall continue to report on any notifiable diseases that may occur through the SDO-Disease Surveillance Dashboard.
4. Furthermore, all private schools are enjoined to adhere to the said precautions to ensure the safety and security of our learners and personnel.

REITERATION OF THE PREVENTIVE MEASURES FOR MPOX

- Attached is a letter from the Department of Health – Davao Center for Health Development dated May 28, 2025, acknowledging the risks of Mpox in the Region and the need for the public to know the common signs and symptoms and its preventive measures.
- Anent to this, to ensure the safety and well-being of everyone especially during the resumption of classes, it is encouraged to follow these minimum public health standards for Mpox in the offices/schools for effective control and prevention:
 - Practice good hand hygiene – ensuring access to handwashing facilities with soap or sanitizers;
 - Sanitizing frequently touched surfaces;
 - Monitoring symptoms;
 - Avoiding close contact with sick persons;
 - Quarantining/isolating person with contagious disease; and
 - Seeking immediate consultation.
- Furthermore, this Office reiterates RM ESSD-2024-390 on the implementation of **Project SHIELD** (Strategic Health Intervention to Emerging health threats thru IEC for Learners and educators in Davao Region) in schools and Offices as its proactive countermeasures to notifiable diseases and health events. School heads and health personnel on-duty shall conduct daily monitoring of health status of learners and personnel, and maintain a record on health status through **submission of reports to the Regional Office on suspected, probable, and confirmed cases of notifiable diseases through Google Sheets via <https://bit.ly/SchoolDseSurv2k25>**.
- Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.

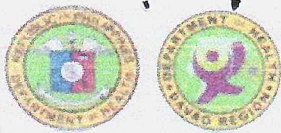
