

Mabuhay ang Araw ng Kasarinlan!

The National Flag Day in the Philippines is celebrated on May 28 in commemoration of the first use of the Philippine Flag after the victory in the Battle of Alapan in 1898 where the Filipino revolutionaries led by Emilio Aguinaldo defeated the Spanish troops. Half a month later, on June 12, 1898, the same flag was raised by Emilio Aguinaldo at his residence in Kawit, Cavite following the proclamation of independence from Spain.

The period from *May 28 to June 12* of every year is declared as **National Flag Days** where all offices, agencies and instrumentalities of the government, business establishments, institutions of learning, private buildings and homes are enjoined to **display the National Flag**. Implementing Rules and Regulations on the use of the Philippine National Flag are provided on Republic Act 8491 otherwise known as the **“Code of the National Flag, Anthem, Motto, Coat-of-Arms, and Other Heraldic Items and Devices of the Philippines”**.

Similarly, the entire nation will commemorate the declaration of Philippine Independence from the Spanish foes on June 12, 2025 and we are now on its **127th Anniversary of the Philippine Independence**. The City of Panabo shall commemorate this memorable day with **Flag-Raising and Wreath-Laying Ceremonies on June 12, 2025 – 7:00 A.M. at the Museo Panabo Grounds, Parks and Plaza, Panabo City**.

In this note, you are cordially invited to join and participate as we celebrate the Independence Day 2025. You are advised to bring wreath of flowers for the Wreath-Laying Ceremony. Also, you are enjoined to display the Philippine National Flag from May 28 to June 12, 2025 at your respected offices.
