GENERAL GUIDELINES

1. The contest is open to **Grade 4 to Grade 6 elementary students from private schools** in Panabo City.
 - Participants must be bona fide students and present a valid school ID upon registration.
2. Students are encouraged to wear their school uniforms during the competition.
3. Interested participants must register by filling out the official registration form available at the CDRRM Operations Center, located at New City Hall Compound, Brgy. JP Laurel, Panabo City.
4. **Registration Deadline: July 25, 2025**
 - Only 10 slots are available.
 - First come, first served basis.

CONTEST MECHANICS

5. The poster must reflect this year's official theme:
"KUMIKILOS (Kayang Umakasyon ng Mamamayan na Isabuhay ang Kahandaan ng bawat Isa para maging Ligtas sa Oras ng Sakuna) para sa Kahandaan, Kaligtasan at Katatagan."
 6. Each participant may submit only one (1) entry.
 7. The artwork must be created on a 1/4-size illustration board, in portrait orientation.
 - The illustration board will be provided by the organizers.
 8. Allowed art media include:
 - Pencil - Markers
 - Acrylic - Poster paint
 - Watercolor - Color pastels

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QUIZ BEE GUIDELINES & MECHANICS

GENERAL GUIDELINES

1. Participants must be bona fide **Junior High School students of any public school** in Panabo City.
2. A total of five (5) schools will compete in the Quiz Bee.
 - Each school shall send two (2) Junior High School participants.
3. Interested participants must register by filling out the official registration form available at the CDRRM Operations Center, located at New City Hall Compound, Brgy. JP Laurel, Panabo City.
4. **Registration deadline: July 25, 2025**
 - **Only five (5) slots are available**
 - **First come, first served basis**
5. The use of gadgets or reference materials during the competition is strictly prohibited.
6. All necessary materials such as whiteboards, markers, and sound effects (bell) will be provided by the organizers on the day of the event.
7. All participants must be at the venue at least 30 minutes before the competition proper.
 - The Quiz Bee will begin promptly at the scheduled time.
 - Late participants will not be allowed to join the competition.
8. The Quiz Master will read each question twice. After the second reading, the Quiz Master will say "GO", signaling the teams to write their answers.
 - After the time is up, participants must immediately raise their boards.
 - Late answers will not be accepted.
9. Correct spelling is required in the Identification Round. Incorrect spelling will be marked wrong.
10. The competition will consist of three rounds:
 - Easy Round
 - Average Round
 - Difficult Round
11. Coverage of the Quiz Bee is based on Republic Act No. 10121 (Philippine Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Act of 2010).
12. Students are encouraged to wear their school uniforms during the competition.
13. Winners will be awarded immediately after the competition during the culmination program on July 31 at the Panabo City Gymnasium.
