

In search of someone who can serve as her tutor, a tricycle driver invited her to come with him with false pretense to teach her. Luckily she was saved in time. Through a public service TV program, they were united with her mother. The call for child protection became necessary not only in the school but also in their own household.

Alghren finally found his extraordinary teacher Anastacia Ledesma who is now affected with the early signs of dementia. He remembered how she patiently served him, taught him, and defended him when he came to school with slippers instead of shoes because of a wound on his heel. She was always an inspiration to him up until now. That is why he bestowed on her the Lifetime Education Award to serve as an inspiration to others too.


