Greetings!

The Department of Environment and Natural Resources—Environmental Management Bureau—XI intends to conduct an online environmental learning activity titled **“Responsible Disposal: Hazardous Waste Management in Campuses and its Permitting Requirements, and Ending the Global Plastic Pollution”**, which aims to promote environmental awareness and address emerging issues associated with improper disposal of electronic equipment and electronic devices.

The RA 6969 or Toxic Substances and Hazardous and Nuclear Wastes Control Act of 1990, is a Philippine law that regulates the handling, use, and disposal of toxic substances and hazardous wastes. It aims to control and prevent harm to human health and the environment from these substances.

The learning activity will delve into **proper handling, storage, disposal, and requirements for securing permits for Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment (WEEE)** or the M506 under Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) Administrative Order No. 2013-22 (e.g., discarded electrical and electronic devices — busted bulbs, computers, etc.)

In addition, we are intensifying our efforts to combat plastic pollution, leading to a more sustainable future. Participants will also have the opportunity to gain knowledge about RA 11898, also known as the Extended Producers’ Responsibility Act of 2022, an amendment to RA 9003, the Ecological Solid Waste Management Act. This law mandates that large enterprises are responsible for the entire lifecycle of their plastic packaging waste, from design to post-consumer waste management. This law aims to reduce plastic pollution by holding producers accountable for the environmental impact and promoting waste reduction, recovery, and recycling.

In view of this, we invite School Principals, faculty, and staff in various schools in your area of jurisdiction, both elementary and secondary schools, on **August 14, 2025, at 8:30 AM-12:00 pm** through Microsoft Teams with the following link:
