1. The Regional Office through the Education Support Services Division (ESSD) ensures a safe, positive, and rights-based learning environment for all the learners across the Region through the implementation of the Learner Rights and Protection Program.
2. Anent to this, ESSD will hold the Regional Orientation on Learner Rights and Protection Policy and its Supplemental Guidelines on August 26-29, 2025 at the Sunny Point Hotel, Ma-a, Davao City. The activity will be attended by Regional/Division Focal Persons on Learners Rights and Protection, selected Public Schools District Supervisors, and selected elementary and secondary school heads.
3. The activity aims to strengthen the holistic approach in addressing learner rights, protection, and psychosocial concerns by enabling participants to:
 - a. Clarify the roles and responsibilities of DepEd offices and CPC members.
 - b. Enhanced Child Protection Policy mechanisms, including incident reporting and referrals, in coordination with LGUs and community partners.
 - c. Identify psychosocial risks, issues, and concerns affecting learners in schools and communities.
 - d. Demonstrate appropriate responses and develop intervention programs for affected learners.
