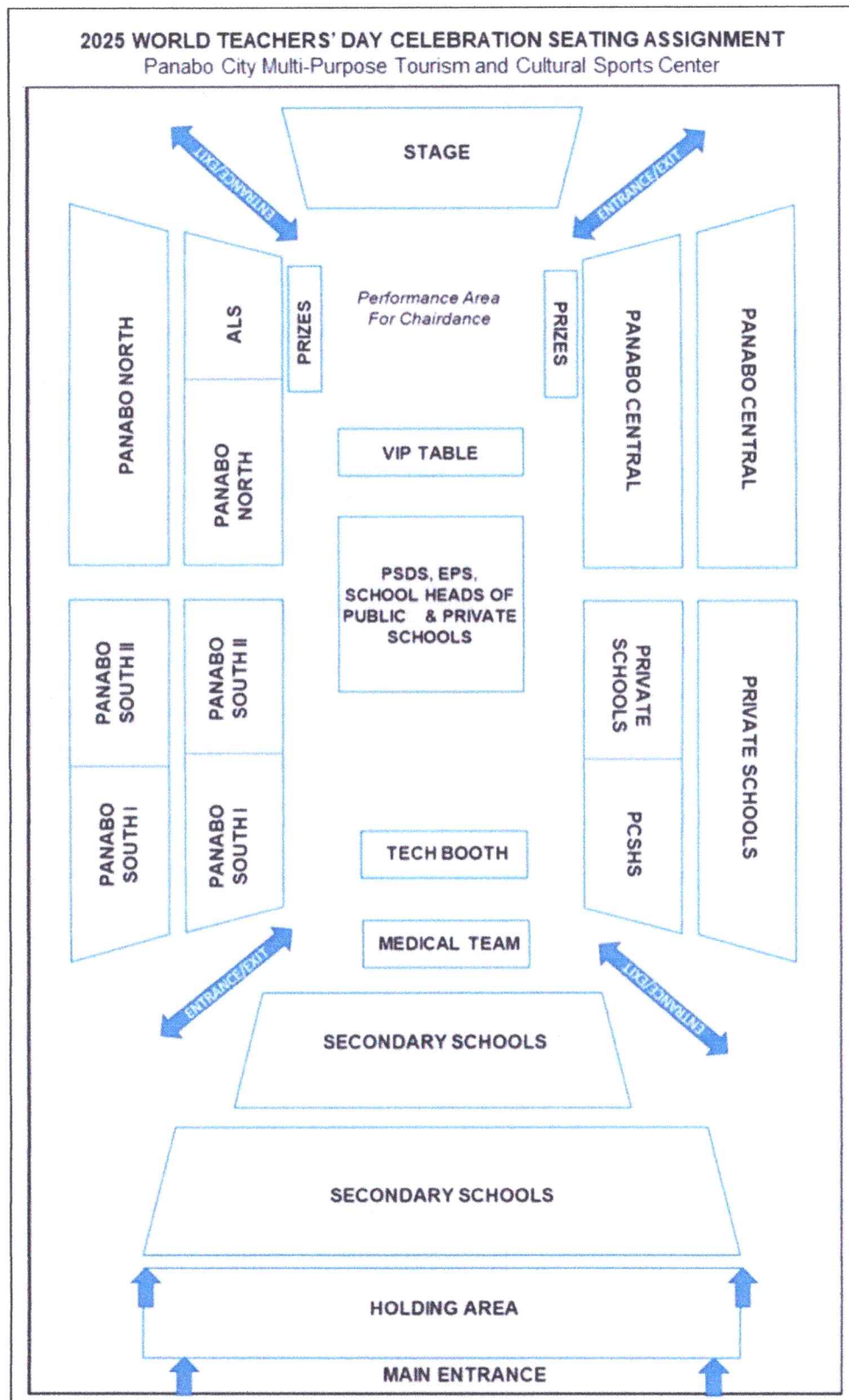

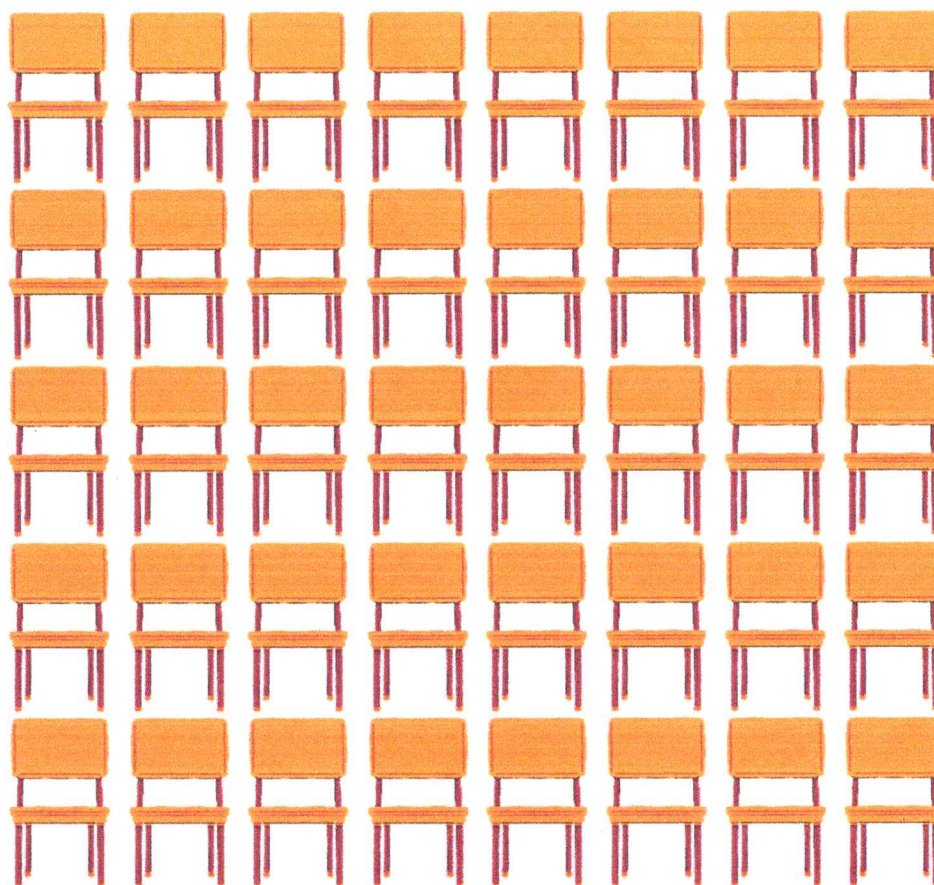
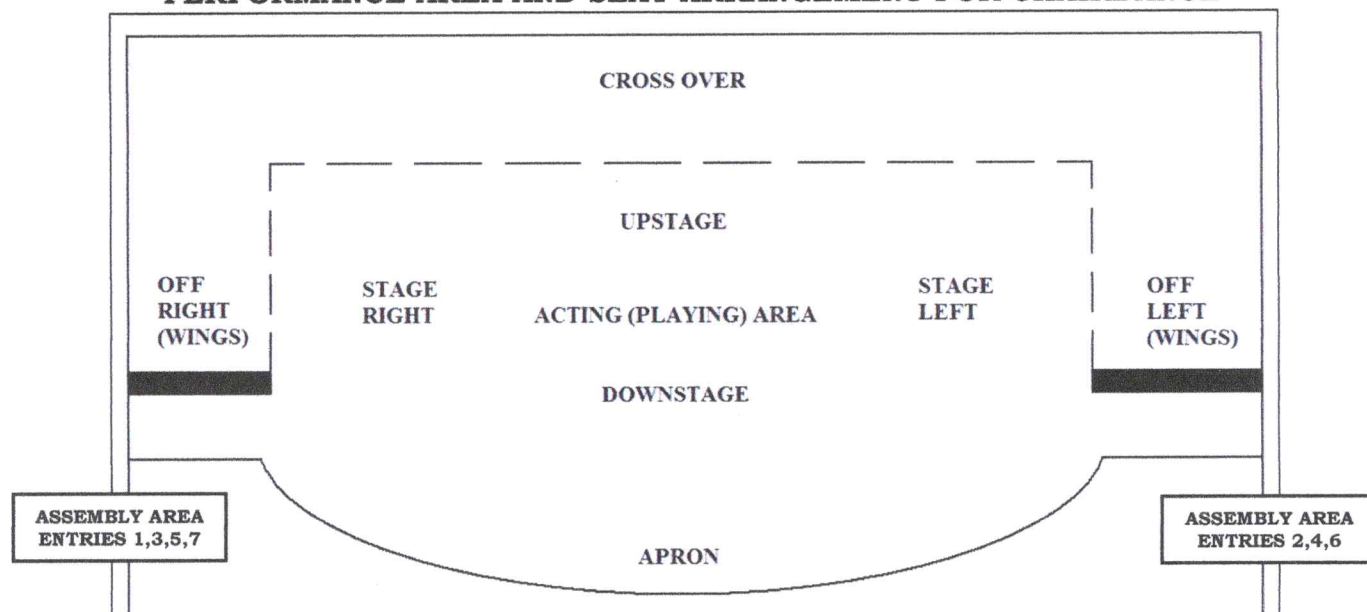

Game # 1: THE FLOOR IS LAVA

Mechanics:

1. Each team should have 6 players, preferably in the 20 to 30 age group.
2. To start the game, each team will be given 5 cardboards to step on.
3. To move forward, the last player will step on the cardboard of the player in front of him/her and pass his/her cardboard to the first player. The first player will step on it and the players behind him/her will follow.
4. The same procedure will be done until they are able to go around the human post and go back to their starting point.
5. However, if a player falls or steps beyond the cardboard, they need to have him/her step back on the cardboard and continue the race.
6. Once a team will be able to finish first, altogether they will shout "Happy World Teacher's Day!"
7. The second and third teams who finish the race and shout the same greetings will also be declared as winners and entitled to get a prize. The rest of the teams will be given consolation prizes.

Game # 2: QUESTION BALLOON POP

Mechanics:

1. Each team should have 6 players, preferably (3 members in the 20-29 age group, and 3 members in the 30-40 age group).
2. To start the game, each group will be given 6 balloons. Each balloon has 1 question placed inside.
3. Then, each player will pop the balloon and answer the question by writing on the paper provided according to the picked item.
4. The same procedure will be done until all players are done popping and answering the questions. They will be given a maximum of 5 minutes to finish the task.
5. However, if the group answers 3 questions incorrectly or has 3 unanswered questions, they will be automatically disqualified.
6. At the end, their scores will be tallied. The group with the highest score will get the first prize. Second and third prize winners will be determined in the same manner. Non-winning teams will receive consolation prizes.
7. Should a tie occur, a toss coin will be done to determine the winner.

Game # 3: GREEN LIGHT, RED LIGHT: DANCE EDITION

Mechanics:

1. This game is inspired by the movie 'Squid Game', in which the players race to the finish line without getting eliminated. Each group should have 6 members, preferably in the 35 to 45 age group.
2. All participants will dance their way towards the finish line when the music is ON (GREEN LIGHT). Those who do not dance when the music is on, will be automatically eliminated.

3. When the music stops (RED LIGHT), the players must immediately freeze. If any movement is seen during red light, the player is eliminated and must leave the field immediately.
4. Players will be given 3 minutes to reach the finish line. The first team with at least 2 members to reach the finish line will get the first prize. The second and third groups to finish the task successfully will also receive their prizes. Consolation prizes will be given as well to the non-winning teams.
5. Should a tie occur, a toss coin will be done to determine the winner.

Game # 4: BLIND SEARCH

Mechanics:

1. Each team should have 6 players, preferably in the 20 to 40 age group.
2. Each group will be assigned a color to be attached in every member's shirt for identification.
3. Each group should choose an animal sound as an identification by shouting it to locate or be identified by their members during the search.
4. All members will be blindfolded and should keep their hands behind their back. Failure of executing this rule will lead them to be automatically eliminated from the game.
5. They will be given a maximum of 5 minutes to do the task.
6. The first group to locate all their members or majority of its members when the time ended will be declared as winner. The second and third groups to finish the task successfully will also receive their prizes. Consolation prizes will be given as well to the non-winning teams.
7. Should a tie occur, a toss coin will be done to determine the winner.

Game # 5: PAPER BALL RELAY

Mechanics:

1. Each team should have 6 players, preferably in the 20 to 45 age group.
2. Each group will be provided a ball.
3. Each member of the group will do a relay through kicking the ball going around their assigned chair, then kick it back to their original post.
4. The game will be given a 5-minute maximum time to complete.
5. The first group to finish the race will receive the first prize. The second and third groups to finish the task successfully will also receive their prizes. Consolation prizes will be given as well to the non-winning teams.
6. Should a tie occur, a toss coin will be done to determine the winner.
