CAKE DECORATION COMPETITION GUIDELINES

RATIONALE:

Participants have to design a cake, working only in the contest zone, while showing their wide variety of skills. The cake shall depict the celebration of a bountiful growing season and unity in the community. The contest is open to all cake makers. There will be two (2) participants per entry. The event will take place on October 09, 2025, 9:00 AM- 4:00 PM at Panabo Multi-Purpose Tourism, Cultural, and Sports Center.

COMPETITION PROCESS:

Registration

- Fill out the Registration form with all the information being asked and submit to PESO on or before October 1, 2025.
- Forms are available in PESO located at City Parks and Plaza, or you may access them through the Panabo City PESO Facebook Page.

Participants

- Participants must be at least 18 years old. A photocopy of the participant's Birth Certificate should be attached to the registration form.
- Submit to PESO the abstract, drawing, or cake design with description on or before October 1, 2025.
- The first five (5) pairs of applicants to submit the form will become the official contestants unless revoked by the organizer due to disqualification.
- Participants are required to be at the venue one (1) hour before the contest proper. Five (5) points will be deducted from the total score who arrive late.
- To ensure an orderly use of working tables during the competition, the organizer will exclusively decide on the designation of the participants.

Rules and Mechanics

1. Cake design must be the original creation of the participants.

Cake Decorating Competition theme must evolve in this year's Binulig Festival **"Maayong BINUhatan alang sa Kinaiyahan. Magpa LIG-on sa Panaboan."**

2. Cake frosting should be made of **fondant**. Cake should withstand the temperature of the venue during the hours of competition. Refrigerated showcases will not be provided. Please plan your designs accordingly.
3. All decorations and toppers MUST BE EDIBLE; however, non-edible but food-safe pillars, dowels, and stabilizers may be used if necessary.
4. You may use any type of cake, such as chiffon, sponge, butter/ moist, and the like. Dummy cakes are prohibited.





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5. All cake bases must be 1ft x 1.5ft. The height of the entire cake output should not exceed 3ft, which includes the topper if available, but not lower than 2ft, preferably 2 tiers of any shape. Cakes are to be entirely decorated by hand. No wiring is allowed. Lace or its equivalent is not allowed. There will be a point deduction for noncompliance.
6. Names of the participants, their business cards, and brochures should not be placed in the final presentation of the cake. Only the **TITLE** and **DESCRIPTION** of the cake will appear on the nameplate to be provided by the participant.
7. The scoring in this competition will be a point system. (Please see Criteria)
8. There will be 3 winners. Winners will receive a trophy and a corresponding cash prize, and a certificate:

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COOKING BANGUS DISH WITH ARTISTIC PLATING GUIDELINES

RATIONALE:

Participants will have to prepare seafood delicacies in which the recipe will highlight the use of Bangus as the main ingredient. A time limit of three (3) hours is allocated for the entire competition. There will be one (1) contestant per entry. The contest is open to all culinary enthusiasts. The event will take place on October 09, 2025, 9:00 AM- 12:00 PM at Panabo Multi-Purpose Tourism Cultural and Sports Center.

COMPETITION PROCESS:

Registration

- Fill out the application form with all the information being asked and submit to PESO on or before October 1, 2025.
- Forms are available in PESO located at City Parks and Plaza, or you may access it through Panabo City PESO Facebook page.

Participants

- Participants are open to all currently enrolled Senior High School students.
- Each participant must be duly endorsed by their respective school through an official letter or endorsement signed by the school head or designated representative.
- The first five (5) applicants to submit the form will become the official contestants unless revoked by the organizer due to disqualification.
- Contestants are required to be at the venue one (1) hour before the contest proper. Five (5) points will be deducted from the total score who arrive late.
- To ensure an orderly use of working tables during the competition, the organizer will exclusively decide on the designation of the participants.

Rules and Mechanics

1. Participants must prepare a seafood dish in which the recipe will highlight the use of Bangus as the main ingredient; **3 sets of canapés and 1 main dish.**
2. Participants must provide their **OWN ingredients and cooking utensils and/or equipment.**
3. All participants are requested to wear proper cooking attire. Each must bring at least three (3) plain white kitchen towels.
4. All preparation and cooking dishes, including garnishes, must be entirely made and crafted on the spot, except for the fish (pre-cleaned). The participants who bring in any cooked item will be disqualified. Before the competition starts, each working area will be checked by the committee.





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5. Each participant should prepare serving plates, spoons, and forks for the judges during tasting.
6. Names of the participants, their business cards, and brochures should not be placed in the final presentation. Only the **TITLE** and **DESCRIPTION** of the dish will appear on the nameplate to be provided by the participant.
7. The participants will be given a total of three (3) hours broken down into three (3) segments. The dish is to be served and displayed at the designated table and area.

Segment 1 (30 min): Mise en place

Segment 2 (2 hours): Preparation, Cooking, plating, and final touch for entrée.

Segment 3 (30 min): Clean up, and organization of the competition area.

8. The scoring in this competition will be a point system. (Please see Criteria)
9. There will be 3 winners. Winners will receive a trophy and a corresponding cash prize, and a plaque.

DISH GARDENING COMPETITION GUIDELINES

RATIONALE:

Participants are tasked to design a creative and eco-friendly dish garden that combines art, environmental awareness, and sustainability. This involves arranging a variety of small plants in a shallow dish or container to create a miniature garden landscape. The activity encourages young participants to connect with nature while developing creativity, responsibility, and an appreciation for plant life. A time limit of three (3) hours is allocated for the entire competition. One (1) contestant per entry is allowed. The event will take place on October 09, 2025, from 1:00 PM to 4:00 PM at the Panabo Multi-Purpose Tourism, Cultural and Sports Center.

COMPETITION PROCESS:

Registration

- Fill out the Registration form with all the information being asked and submit to PESO on or before October 1, 2025.
- Forms are available in PESO located at City Parks and Plaza, or you may access them through the Panabo City PESO Facebook page.

Participants

- Participants are open to all currently enrolled elementary students in any schools in **Panabo City only**.
- Each participant must be duly endorsed by their respective school through an official letter or endorsement form signed by the school head or designated representative.
- Submit to PESO the abstract, drawing, or dish garden design with description on or before October 1, 2025.
- The first five (5) applicants to submit the form will become the official contestants unless revoked by the organizer due to disqualification.
- Participants are required to be at the venue one (1) hour before the contest proper. Five (5) points will be deducted from the total score who arrive late.
- To ensure an orderly use of working tables during the competition, the organizer will exclusively decide on the designation of the participants.

Rules and Mechanics

1. The dish garden must be original and created on the spot within the allotted time. Dish Gardening Competition must evolve in this year's Binulig Festival "**Maayong BINUhatan alang sa Kinaiyahan. Magpa LIG-on sa Panaboan**" theme.
2. No pre-arranged or pre-decorated gardens will be accepted.
3. For the materials, **participants must bring:**
 - **Dish or Container:** Must be shallow and portable (minimum diameter of 8–12 inches). May be made of clay, ceramic, plastic, recycled materials, or any eco-friendly alternative.
 - **Plants:** Live plants such as succulents, cacti, herbs, moss, ferns, or other small ornamental plants. At least three different plant varieties are required.
 - **Gardening Materials:** Potting soil, pebbles, sand, moss, compost, and decorative stones.





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- **Decorative Accessories (Optional):** Small figurines, recycled materials, twigs, shells, or natural elements to enhance the design.
- 4. Plants must be real and alive—no artificial or plastic plants allowed.
- 5. Use of harmful chemicals or non-biodegradable decorations is prohibited.
- 6. The entire arrangement must fit within the dish/container provided by the participant.
- 7. Time Limit: Participants will have 3 hours to complete their garden.
- 8. Workspace must be kept clean and safe at all times.
- 9. Participants are responsible for cleaning up after the activity.
- 10. There will be 3 winners. Winners will receive a trophy and a corresponding cash prize.

Rationale:

Participants must showcase their skills in transforming fruits and vegetables into stunning artistic designs. These competitions often focus on creativity, precision, and presentation, combining culinary expertise with artistry. A time limit of three (3) hours is allocated for the entire competition. There will be one (1) contestant per entry. The event will take place on October 09, 2025, 9:00 AM- 12:00 noon at Panabo Multi- Purpose Tourism Cultural and Sports Center.

Competition Process

Registration:

- Fill out the Registration form with all the information being asked and submit to PESO on or before October 1, 2025.
- Forms are available in PESO located at City Parks and Plaza, or you may access them through the Panabo City PESO Facebook page.

Participants:

- Participants are open to all currently enrolled Senior High School students.
- Each participant must be duly endorsed by their respective school through an official letter or endorsement signed by the school head or designated representative.
- The first five (5) applicants to submit the form will become the official contestants unless revoked by the organizer due to disqualification.
- Contestants are required to be at the venue one (1) hour before the contest proper. Five (5) points will be deducted from the total score who arrive late.
- To ensure an orderly use of working tables during the competition, the organizer will exclusively decide on the designation of the participants.

Rules:

- Contestants have three (3) hours to carve one composition. Within this timeframe, Contestants must finish their carving and assemble their displays and clean their work station, remove all waste and tools from the table, and hand over the workplace to a judge in proper condition.
- Contestant must prepare its exhibit from scratch; no preparation in advance will be allowed.
- The contestant is allowed in the competition area 30 minutes before the start of the competition to set up their working space and display area.
- Before starting the competition, all the rules of the category will be announced to the contestants.
- Each contestant will be assigned to a working table and a chair. The table provided will be used for working as well as setting up the finished piece. All other materials, such as garbage bins, tools, cutting boards, a water container, cleaning materials, and the fruits and vegetables, must be brought by the participant.
- Each participant shall place his/her entry card at his/her carving station.





- The contestant may use a combination of fruits and vegetables, and must include a banana. He/She may carve as many fruits and vegetables as necessary for the presentation. There will only be one presentation for every contestant.
- Products must be clean but not peeled.
- All items must be placed on the table. No items underneath the table are allowed, except a garbage container and a container with water.
- All carvings will be exhibited until the end of the competition. Early removal of the carvings is not allowed.
- During the competition, participants will wear their professional cooking uniforms.

Composition and Presentation

- The objects have to be ready within the time allotted. Unfinished pieces result in a deduction of points.
- Carving must be pleasing, not aggressive or violent. If found offensive, objects may be removed by the judges or the organizer.
- Participants are encouraged to use various carving elements and techniques.
- The theme must evolve in this year's Binulig Festival **"Maayong BINUhatan alang sa Kinaiyahan. Magpa LIG-on sa Panaboan."**
- Demonstration of innovative and creative ideas.
- Objects proportionate and well balanced.
- The objects must look fresh during the whole length of the event.
- The scoring in this competition will be a point system. (Please see Criteria)
- There will be 3 winners who will be ranked as 1st to 3rd, respectively. Winners will receive a corresponding cash prize and plaque.

BARTENDING WITH FLAIR AND MIXOLOGY COMPETITION GUIDELINES

RATIONALE:

To expose the skills of the participants through their creativity in mixing drinks and alcoholic concoctions in a stylish way to produce amazing cocktails. Prepared drinks must evolve in this year's Binulig Festival theme, "Maayong BINUhatan alang sa Kinaiyahan. Magpa LIG-on sa Panaboan." There will be (1) one participant per entry. The contest is open to all bartenders. The event will take place on October 9, 2025, from 1:00 AM- 4:00 PM at Panabo Multi-Purpose Tourism Cultural and Sports Center.

COMPETITION PROCESS:

Registration

- Fill out the application form with all the information being asked and submit it to PESO Panabo on or before October 1, 2025.
- Forms are available in PESO Panabo located at City Parks and Plaza, or you may access it through Panabo City PESO Facebook page.

Participants

- Participants must be at least 18 years old. A photocopy of the participant's Birth Certificate should be attached to the registration form.
- The first five (5) applicants to submit the form will become the official participants unless revoked by the organizer due to disqualification.
- Participants are required to be at the venue one (1) hour before the contest proper. Five (5) points will be deducted from the total score who arrive late.

Rules and Mechanics

1. Participants will be given 5 minutes to create a special concoction using Rum as the base.
2. Participants should use fresh/frozen Cavendish bananas as flavoring. It may be mixed with other flavorings, but the taste and aroma of banana should be present.
3. All contestants are responsible for the ingredients and materials needed to make the drink of their choice, including his/her rubber mat. Ingredients brought by the participants should be bottled and labeled.
4. All participants shall wear: White long sleeves with tie/bow, black pants/ skirt, and black shoes.
5. Each bartender must utilize both working and exhibition flair.
6. The organizers will ONLY provide the following: Table for Preparation and Electrical extensions.
7. Participants will prepare his/her own entry on the spot. However, he/she will be given 15 mins to prepare the materials on the working table provided before execution. Participants are allowed (2) two persons to help them in setting up the area ONLY during the allotted time.
8. Participants are to use standard glassware for presentation and three testers for the judges.
9. The finalists will be judged on wine service and bar knowledge.





10. Participants must bring a printed copy of the mixed cocktail ingredients and submit them to the organizer on the day of the competition.

11. One (1) point will be deducted for every fall.

12. The scoring in this competition will be a point system. (Please see Criteria)

13. There will be 3 winners. Winners will receive a certificate and a corresponding cash prize:

2nd Prize P 6,000.00

3rd Prize P 4,000.00

15. Non-winning entries will receive a Consolation Prize of P 1,500.00 each and a certificate.
