**ADVISORY ON THE SUSPENSION OF FACE-TO-FACE CLASSES,
IMPLEMENTATION OF ALTERNATIVE DELIVERY MODES,
AND RESUMPTION OF WORK**

1. In view of the suspension of face-to-face classes on **October 13, 2025**, as per Executive Order No. 70, series of 2025, all public and private schools shall shift to Alternative Delivery Modes (ADM) to ensure that learning continues despite the current situation.
2. Teachers are hereby advised to report to their respective schools to:
 - Conduct virtual classes and virtual reading activities;
 - Monitor learners' progress through modular learning in their respective Google Classrooms or other established platforms; and
 - Perform other related tasks as may be assigned by their school heads.
3. School Heads are expected to monitor the conduct of these activities and submit Means of Verification (MOVs) to their respective Public Schools District Supervisors for consolidation and submission to higher offices.
4. While we continue to prioritize the safety and well-being of our learners, teachers, and personnel, we remain steadfast in our mandate to ensure that learning never stops.
5. Work in the Division Office shall resume normal operations.



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6. Private schools shall have the authority to issue their own advisories regarding their respective school operations, consistent with the provisions of Executive Order No. 70 and other relevant DepEd policies.
7. Let us continue to uphold our shared commitment to education while prioritizing the safety of all. Everyone is likewise reminded to remain vigilant and to adhere to official advisories and updates from reliable sources.
8. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
