1. Attached is Regional Memorandum No. ESSD-2025-157 dated October 14, 2025, entitled re: "REITERATION OF THE PREVENTIVE MEASURES FOR INFLUENZA-LIKE ILLNESS AND SUBMISSION OF DAILY CASES TRACKER" which reiterates the safety and well-being of everyone.
2. Anent this, all school and offices shall follow the minimum public health standards for influenza for the effective control and prevention:
 - a. Practice good hand hygiene
 - b. Practice proper coughing and sneezing etiquette
 - c. Sanitizing frequently touched surfaces
 - d. Monitoring of symptoms
 - e. Avoiding close contact with sick person
 - f. Avoiding touching of face especially eyes, nose and mouse to prevent germ entry
 - g. Quarantining/isolating person with contagious diseases
 - h. Seeking immediate consultation
3. Further, all schools shall continue to report any notifiable diseases through the disease surveillance dashboard while the **report on the Influenza-like illnesses (ILI) shall be conducted daily**. Cut off time shall be every **4:00 PM**.

REITERATION OF THE PREVENTIVE MEASURES FOR INFLUENZA-LIKE ILLNESS
AND SUBMISSION OF DAILY CASES TRACKER

To: Schools Division Superintendents

1. Relative to the seasonal increase of influenza-like illnesses, this Office through the Education Support Services Division reiterates the safety and well-being of everyone. It is encouraged that everyone should follow these minimum public health standards for influenza in the offices/schools for effective control and prevention:
 - a. Practice good hand hygiene – ensuring access to handwashing facilities with soap or sanitizers;
 - b. Practice proper coughing and sneezing etiquette;
 - c. Sanitizing frequently touched surfaces;
 - d. Monitoring of symptoms;
 - e. Avoiding close contact with sick persons;
 - f. Avoiding touching of face especially eyes, nose, and mouth to prevent germ entry;
 - g. Quarantining/isolating person with contagious disease; and
 - h. Seeking immediate consultation.
3. Furthermore, this Office reiterates RM ESSD-2024-390 or the implementation of **Project SHIELD** (Strategic Health Intervention to Emerging health threats thru IEC for Learners and educators in Davao Region) in schools and Offices as its proactive countermeasures to notifiable diseases and health events. School heads and health personnel on-duty shall conduct daily monitoring of health status of learners and personnel, and maintain a record on health status through **submission of reports to the Regional Office on cases of influenza-like illnesses daily through Google Sheets via <https://bit.ly/SchoolDseSurv2k25>**. Cut-off time for the reports will be at 5:00 pm.
4. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
