The **Philippine Package of Essential Non- Communicable Disease Intervention (PhilPEN)**, a program of Department of Health (DOH) focused on early detection, prevention and management of Non- Communicable Diseases (NCD's), such as Hypertension and Diabetes which target individuals aged 20 years old and above.


