Pursuant to DepEd Memorandum No. 087, s. 2025, the Schools Division of Panabo City, through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID), hereby informs all concerned on the administration of the Early Language, Literacy and Numeracy Program Assessment (ELLNA) on Friday, **November 7, 2025**, for the currently enrolled **Grade 4 learners** in all public elementary schools in this Division.

The administration of ELLNA is pursuant to DO 029, s. 2022, titled Adoption of the Basic Education Monitoring and Evaluation Framework, as it measures the level of proficiency of key stage 1 learners in terms of language, literacy, and numeracy. This measure shall be used to assess the effectiveness and efficiency of the delivery of education services and the improvement of the curriculum implementation. It is also aligned with DO 012, s. 2025, titled Multi-year Implementing Guidelines on the School Calendar and Activities which ensures the timely implementation of the agency's programmed activities and services.

Relative to this, all Chief Examiners (CE) and School Testing Coordinators (STC) are enjoined to gather on **November 6, 2025** at 8:00 in the morning for the **orientation** and **distribution of testing materials** at the Activity Area of the Library Hub, PCESSC Compound.

Please refer to the inclosures for the list of monitors, testing centers, involved testing personnel, and other pertinent details. It is expected that Chief Examiners and School Testing Coordinators shall have oriented their respective room examiners before their deployment to their assigned schools, using the information they received in the Division Orientation and the Examiner's Handbook.

In case the listed room examiners are not available due to valid reasons, the school head is responsible for issuing school-based memorandum to replace them and ensure that the number of required proctors are still complied.

All Education Program Supervisors, Public Schools District Supervisors, and Chiefs are enjoined to conduct appropriate monitoring and evaluation during the assessment schedule to ensure that the test standards are strictly implemented and complied with.

Meals, transportation, and other incidental expenses incurred relative to the assessment may be charged against downloaded NASBE Program Support Funds, Division/School MOOE, or any available local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

This memorandum supersedes all previous issuances of the same matter.
