The **Philippine Package of Essential Non- Communicable Disease Intervention (PhilPEN)**, a program of Department of Health (DOH) focused on early detection, prevention and management of Non-Communicable Diseases (NCD's), such as Hypertension and Diabetes which target individuals aged 20 years old and above.



On this note, we would like to invite eight (8) Division and School Nurses and one (1) Physician to participate this said orientation and who will actively put on this program in your institution.


