ELEMENTARY LEVEL**

◆ VOCAL SOLO CONTEST

A total of eight (8) contestants will be accommodated, and registration will be on a first-come, first-served basis.

Mechanics

1. Open to all Grade 1 to Grade 6 learners from both public and private schools in Panabo City.
2. Only one (1) entry per school, or sector (PWD, Center-based, NGO)
3. The song that will be rendered must be Original Pilipino Music (OPM).
4. The contest piece should be in English, or Filipino, or any Philippines dialect.
5. The contestant will be given 5 minutes for preparation, and each performance must not exceed 3 to 5 minutes.
6. Performances beyond 5 minutes will have a corresponding 1-point deduction per second.
7. The accompaniment must be in the form of a minus without backup singers within the music.
8. Contestants must wear formal attire

• Vocal Quality, Rhythm, and Diction	45%
• Expression, Emotion and Showmanship	35%
• Costume (Overall Impression and Stage Presence)	<u>20%</u>

MODERN FOLK DANCE CONTEST

A total of nine (9) entries will be accommodated, and registration will be on a first-come, first-served basis.

Mechanics

1. Open to all Grade 1 to Grade 6 learners from both public and private schools in Panabo City.
2. Only one (1) entry per school, or sector (PWD, Center-based, NGO)
3. Each group must consist of a minimum of 10 and a maximum of 15 elementary pupils, including props men. A 3-point deduction from the final average score will be applied for any shortage or excess in the number of participants.
4. The dance is open with a fiesta type of Philippine Folk Dance creatively.
5. Staging must be implemented and the team is allowed to modify the music, dance steps and costumes.
6. Each group is free to delete, cut, insert and jumble their music as long as it is in conformity to their assigned performances.
7. The performance time will be limited to a minimum of 5 and a maximum of 7 minutes. Lack or excess on the required time duration will result to deduction of 3 points to the final average.
8. Each group should choose their own costume. Costumes must not be violent or dangerous in any way. It must not contain pointed object that may possibly inflict harm on the other and the members themselves.
9. Costumes must be decent. They must not attract malice in any way thus, revealing outfits are not allowed.
10. Use of props will be allowed as long as it will not cause any delay in the program and any harm to the performance of other groups. Props such as oil, fire, confetti, pyrotechnic gadgets, smoke generators or combustible material, broken glass, live animals, sharp objects and the like are prohibited.
11. Judge's decision is final and irrevocable.

↳ VOCAL SOLO CONTEST

A total of eight (8) contestants will be accommodated, and registration will be on a first-come, first-served basis.

Mechanics

1. Open to all Grade 7 to Grade 10 learners from both public and private schools in Panabo City, aged 17 and below.
2. Only one (1) entry per school, or sector (PWD, Center-based, NGO).
3. The song that will be rendered must be Original Pilipino Music (OPM).
4. The contest piece should be in English, or Filipino, or any Philippines dialect.
5. The contestant will be given 5 minutes for preparation, and each performance must not exceed 3 to 5 minutes.
6. Performances beyond 5 minutes will have a corresponding 1-point deduction per second.
7. The accompaniment must be in the form of a minus without backup singers within the music.
8. Contestants must wear formal attire

• Costume (Overall Impression and Stage Presence)	20%

↳ FIELD DEMO CONTEST

A total of eight (8) entries will be accommodated, and registration will be on a first-come, first-served basis.

Mechanics

1. Open to all Grade 7 to Grade 10 learners from both public and private schools in Panabo City, aged 17 and below.
2. Only one (1) entry per school, or sector (PWD, Center-based, NGO)

3. Each group must consist of a minimum of 15 and a maximum of 20 secondary students, including props men. A 3-point deduction from the final average score will be applied for any shortage or excess in the number of participants.
4. The group performance must reflect the values and rights of children and creative interpretations through music, dance, costumes, and props are highly encouraged.
5. Staging must be implemented and the team is allowed to modify the music, dance steps and costumes.
6. Each group is free to delete, cut, insert and jumble their music as long as it is in conformity to their assigned performances.
7. The performance time will be limited to a minimum of 4 and a maximum of 6 minutes. Lack or excess on the required time duration will result to deduction of 3 points to the final average.
8. Each group should choose their own costume. Costumes must not be violent or dangerous in any way. It must not contain pointed object that may possibly inflict harm on the other and the members themselves.
9. Costumes must be decent. They must not attract malice in any way thus, revealing outfits are not allowed.
10. Use of props will be allowed as long as it will not cause any delay in the program and any harm to the performance of other groups. Props such as oil, fire, confetti, pyrotechnic gadgets, smoke generators or combustible material, broken glass, live animals, sharp objects and the like are prohibited.
11. Judge's decision is final and irrevocable.
