4. **Safety and Security** – The safety and security of learners shall be always ensured, particularly during travel to and from practices, rehearsals, and competitions.

Entries submitted after the set deadline will not be entertained. **LATE SUBMISSION WITH INCOMPLETE DOCUMENTS SHALL NOT BE ENTERTAINED OR ACCEPTED.**
3. The contestants of the different categories must be a bona fide student of the school they are representing and are currently enrolled in the category they are competing. Only one (1) representative per category of the school is allowed.
4. Each contestant must use his/her own laptop during the contest. **Bring also extension wire.** An output must be in an **8.5 inches x 11 inches in size and a landscape orientation** using **Adobe Photoshop Platform (in any version) will do.**
5. The contestants will be given two (2) hours to design and layout. The Competition shall be held at **Barangay Salvacion Covered Court, Panabo City on November 17, 2025, 1:00 PM in the afternoon.**

A separate announcement will be posted to our FB Page of the date on when to claim the prizes.
