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GUIDELINES ON THE CONDUCT OF MUSABAQAH

| Event | Participant | Mechanics |
|-----------------------------|---|---|
| 1. Harf Touch | *one participant, *ages 6-7 years old * from grade 1 | *Identify the 28 letters engraved on illustration board within 1 minute *One point shall be given for every correct answer *The participant with the highest number of current answer in a shortest recorded time shall be declared as the winner. In case of tie, another 3 letters shall be added to the 28 letters for the clincher round. |
| 2. Qur'an Reading | *one participant, *ages 9-11 years old *from any grade level | *Read the selected passage/selection (verse/ayah or chapter/surah) in Tarteel. *Must be in proper attire *Each contestant will be given a copy of the passage to read silently for 5 minutes before he/she read it orally within 5 minutes |
| 3. Arabic Language Spelling | One participant From any grade level 1-6 Age – 6-11 years old | There will be 3 rounds (Easy, Average and Difficult round) Point system-Easy- 1 point -Average- 3 points - Difficult – 5 points - Coaches will provide 1(one) word each round - Judges will read the word and determine the correctness in writing and the contestant will write the word in Arabic form |

Call to Prayer | <ul style="list-style-type: none">*one participant,*ages 6-9 years old* from any grade level | <p>*Perform "Call to Prayer" in a maximum of 5 minutes including the preparation.</p> <p>*Point Five will be deducted if time exceeds</p> <p>*Only Muslim male learner is qualified to perform the Adhan.</p> |
| 5. Naseehah-Oration | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• One Participant (Male or Female)• Age 6 – 11 years old from any grade level• | <p>Deliver the Oration piece in 3 to 5 minutes</p> <p>Must be in Proper Attire</p> <p>Contestant must have an Oration piece in line with the given theme:</p> <p>Judges will determine the winner</p> |
