DATE: November 4, 2025

In observance of the 18-Day Campaign to End Violence Against Women (VAW), pursuant to Proclamation No. 1172 (s. 2006) and Republic Act No. 9710 (Magna Carta of Women), the City Government of Panabo joins the nationwide advocacy led by the Philippine Commission on Women (PCW) from November 25 to December 12, 2025.

The kick-off and opening ceremony of the citywide campaign will be held on **TUESDAY**, November 25, 2025, to signal Panabo City's commitment to a violence-free community.

- Assembly Area: Panabo City Hall Grounds
- Motorcade Start: 7:00 AM
- Opening Program: Immediately after the motorcade at Panabo Multi-Purpose Gym

All Department Heads are hereby enjoined to attend and lead the participation of their respective offices during the motorcade and the opening program.

To show solidarity with the global call to "Orange the World" — the official color of the campaign symbolizing a future free from violence — all city employees and participants are required to wear ORANGE attire during the kick-off ceremony on November 25, 2025.

Departments are encouraged to display orange-themed decorations or ribbons within their respective offices throughout the campaign period (November 25 – December 12, 2025).

The Gender and Development Office (GAD), in collaboration with the City GFPS and Secretariat, shall coordinate the overall logistics, motorcade lineup, and program flow. Department Heads are requested to ensure full participation and cooperation of their personnel.
