The details of the event are as follows:

- I. **DATES** : **January 15-18, 2026**
- II. **VENUE** : **Energy Park, Apokon, Tagum City**
- III. **PARTICIPANTS** :
 - Junior Scouts- minimum of 2 patrols and 4 Troop Leaders (2 adult chaperons/ patrol) per district.
 - Senior/ Cadet- minimum of 1 patrol and 1 Troop Leader (1 adult-chaperon per patrol) per secondary school.
- IV. **REGISTRATION** : **P 1,700.00** per delegate (girl and adult) to cover the expenses like food for the whole duration (9 meals and 5 snacks), event shirts, activities/program materials, speakers/facilitator's honorarium/tokens, and other operational expenses.
- V. **MEAL SCHEDULE:** First Meal in Camp: **January 15, 2026, dinner**
Last Meal in Camp: **January 18, 2026, lunch**

May we also request that leaders attending this camp be given **COC/ Service Credits** upon presentation of the Certificate of Appearance and a duly signed Daily Time Record.


